### 1) Commitment TO Christ

The Greek word is (ἀρετή aretē), and William Barclay tells us that it refers to excellence in an operative or practical sense.

It's about **BEHAVIOR!**

- The ESV & KJV translates the word **virtue**.
- NLT & NASV is moral excellence.
- NIV is **goodness**.
- In the Message it's **good character**.

- Worshiping God alone (Exodus 20:3)
- Telling the truth (Ephesians 4:25)
- Sexual purity (1 Thessalonians 4:3-5)
- Loving one’s neighbor (Mark 12:31)
- “Be holy, for I am holy.” (1 Peter 1:16)

# What are “moral” issues?

A **moral issue** is any matter involving **right and wrong as defined by God’s character and revealed will**, rather than merely personal preference, culture, tradition, or wisdom.

A few key principles help identify a moral issue:

## 2. It Involves Sin or Righteousness

- ❑ A moral issue concerns actions, attitudes, words, or motives that God calls sinful or righteous.
- ❑ Jesus emphasized that morality includes not only outward actions but also the heart:
- ❑ **Matthew 15:19 (ESV)** <sup>19</sup> For out of the heart come evil thoughts, murder, adultery, sexual immorality, theft, false witness, slander.

# What are “moral” issues?

A **moral issue** is any matter involving **right and wrong as defined by God’s character and revealed will**, rather than merely personal preference, culture, tradition, or wisdom.

A few key principles help identify a moral issue:

## 3. It Reflects on God’s Character

- ❑ Something is morally right because it **aligns** with God’s nature, and morally wrong because it **contradicts** His nature.
- ❑ Psalms 145:17 <sup>17</sup> The LORD is righteous in all his ways and kind in all his works.

# What are “moral” issues?

A **moral issue** is any matter involving **right and wrong as defined by God’s character and revealed will**, rather than merely personal preference, culture, tradition, or wisdom.

A few key principles help identify a moral issue:

## 4. It Affects Our Relationship with God and Others

- ❑ Jesus summarized God’s moral law with two great commandments:
- ❑ Matt 22:37-39 <sup>37</sup> “You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and ... <sup>39</sup> love your neighbor as yourself.”
- ❑ Questions involving love, justice, truth, faithfulness, purity, mercy, and stewardship are therefore moral issues.

# **A Helpful Test – Simply ASK:**

- ✓ **Does Scripture clearly command or forbid it?**
- ✓ **Does it honor or dishonor God's character?**
- ✓ **Does it express love for God and neighbor?**
- ✓ **Would doing it involve sin according to biblical teaching?**

### 1) Commitment TO Christ

William Barclay tells us that this Greek word (γνῶσις gnōsis) refers to practical knowledge. This isn't "philosophical theory" type of knowledge. This is the type of knowledge that is put to use.

He defines it as... **"KNOWLEDGE which enables a man to decide rightly and to act honorably and efficiently in the day-to-day circumstances of life."**

Instead of chasing down some obscure point in Genesis, read the Sermon on the Mount and put it to work in your life.

### 2) Courage FOR Christ

Barclay's description of this word (ἐγκράτεια egkrateia) best: self-mastery.

Theologian Douglas Moo defines it as "the ability of the human being to act entirely of one's own free will without being subject to the whims and pressures of other people, competing philosophies, or one's own emotions."

Many people think this is the most difficult quality to add but really it is not. It is a matter of being able to say "no".

PHILIPPIANS 4:13 (ESV)

### 2) Courage FOR Christ

The Greek word is (ὑπομονή hypomonē), and it is often translated “patience” but it means, literally, to remain under — in other words, **to persevere. To stick with it.**

In developing this quality, you not only have to learn to endure external opposition, and you must also learn to endure your own mistakes and failures.

*I have known many more professing Christians who walked from their faith after becoming discouraged at their own inability to measure up to the standard more than from peer pressure, criticism or persecution. Steadfastness means simply that you are willing to try again.*

### 2) Courage FOR Christ

The Greek word is (εὐσέβεια eusebeia). It can also be translated piety. When many hear these words — godliness and piety — we get an image of sour-faced, condescending, holier-than-thou religion.

In Greek literature this word is used to describe a person who is in a right relationship with both God (or "the gods") and others — **a person who gives God the worship he deserves, and who treats others with the respect and dignity.**

This is what godliness is all about. The apostle John wrote... God has given us this command: **Whoever loves God must also love his brother.** (1 John 4:21)

### 3) Compassion LIKE Christ

The Greek word is (φιλαδελφία Philadelphia) fraternal affection: — brotherly love (kindness), love of the brethren. BROTHERLY AFFECTION means to show special concern for my brothers and sisters in Christ.

Peter is referring to more than just our being friendly and kind with others. He's talking about building relationships of brotherly love, of mutual affection.

Here's how to develop this quality. **Strengthen your friendships.**

### 3) Compassion LIKE Christ

**Love (agapēn)** is desiring the highest good for others. This is the kind of love God exhibits toward sinners (Jn 3:16; Rom 5:8)  
LOVE means to sacrifice to meet the needs of others.

#### As Paul wrote...

Colossians 3:14 <sup>14</sup> And above all these put on love, which binds everything together in perfect harmony.

#### Jesus said...

John 13:35 <sup>35</sup> By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another.”

**Love is the ultimate expression of Christian holiness.**

# Change by Confronting Reality

## 1) Commitment TO Christ

We need to develop good practical knowledge, and we need to put it into practice with good actions.

**(moral excellence, knowledge.)**

## 2) Courage FOR Christ

We need to develop self-discipline, and we need to keep trying till we get it right.

**(self-control, steadfastness, godliness.)**

## 3) Compassion LIKE Christ

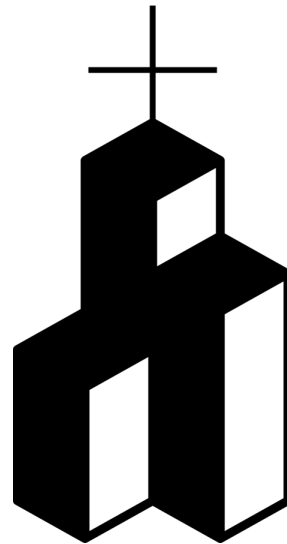
We need to develop love, strengthening relationships with others and worshipping God as he deserves.

**(brotherly affection, love.)**

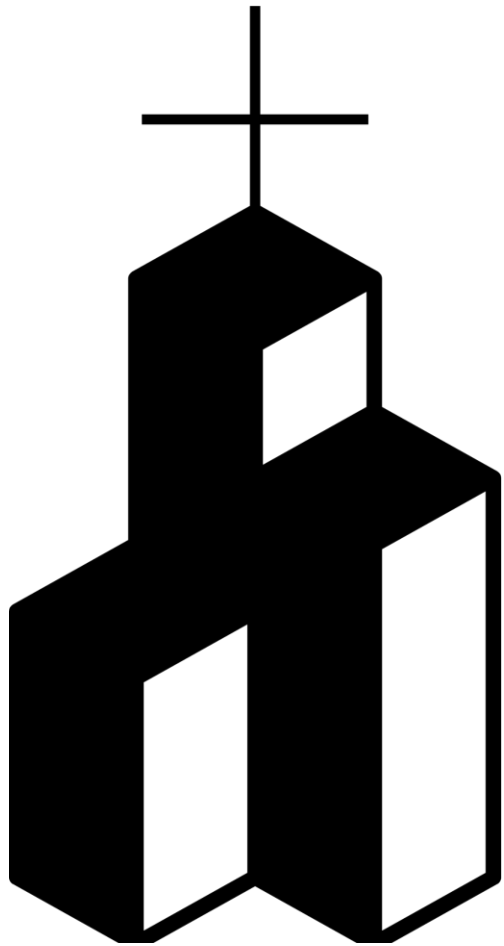

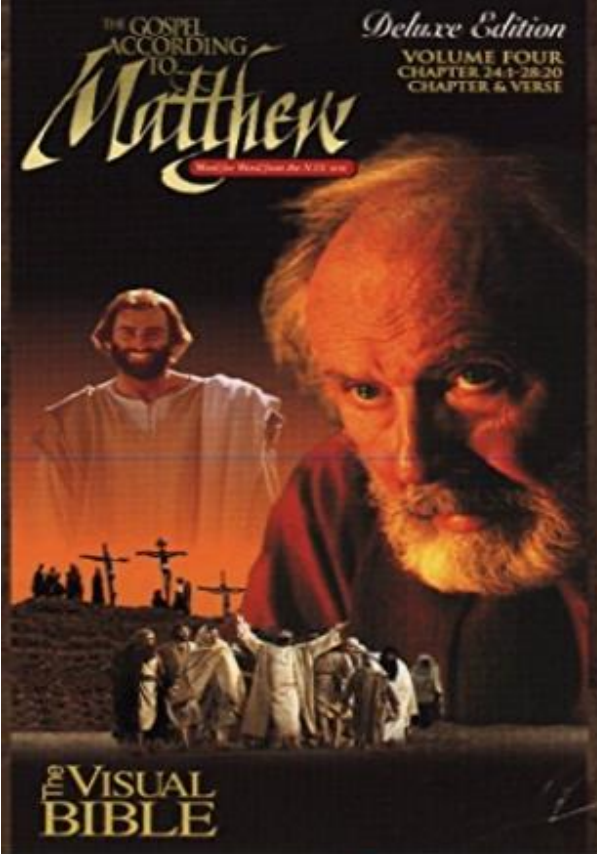

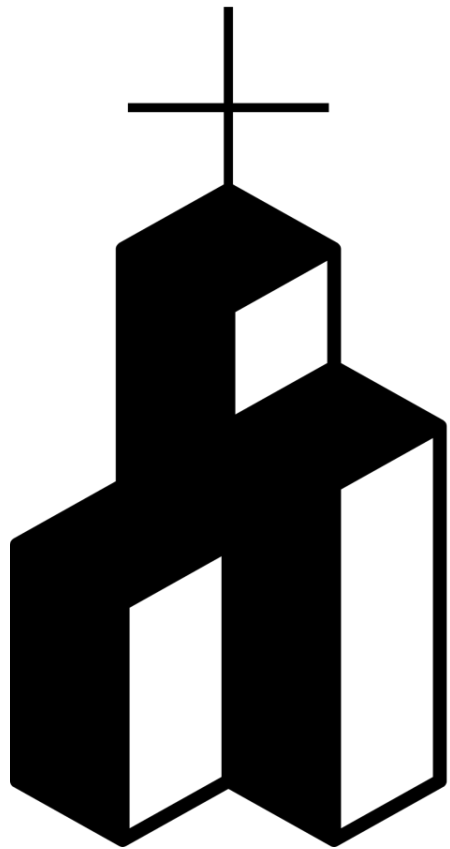
