2 Peter 1:10-21

Introduction to 2 Peter

The book of **2 Peter** is the heartfelt farewell of an aging apostle who knows that his earthly life is drawing to a close (2 Peter 1:13–15). Like a loving shepherd preparing his flock for life without him, Peter writes with deep concern that believers remain steadfast in their faith, grow in Christlike character, resist false teachers, and live in eager expectation of Christ's return.

Peter's heart is not merely that Christians possess saving faith, but that they cultivate a fruitful, mature faith that confirms their calling and glorifies God.

He reminds them that God has already provided everything they need for life and godliness through the knowledge of Jesus Christ. Because of this, believers are to diligently add virtue, knowledge, self-control, steadfastness, godliness, brotherly affection, and love to their faith.

Calling and **choosing** are inseparable realities indicating God's effectual call of believers to salvation (Rom. 11:29; 2 Thess. 2:14; 2 Tim. 1:9; cf. Matt. 4:17; Acts 2:38; 3:19; 17:30) based on God's sovereign election of them in eternity past (Rom. 8:29; Eph. 1:4, 11; Titus 1:2; 1 Peter 2:9). **Peter's concern is that believers have confidence and assurance that they are included in the elect.**
