1. THE HISTORICAL SETTING

Daniel 1:1–7

- **605 BC** Nebuchadnezzar attacks Jerusalem; Daniel and other young men are carried to Babylon.
- **597 BC** A second deportation occurs.
- **586 BC** Jerusalem and the temple are destroyed.

Daniel's ministry extends from Babylon into the early Medo-Persian period — roughly 70 years of faithful service.
