reason to rejoice right now?

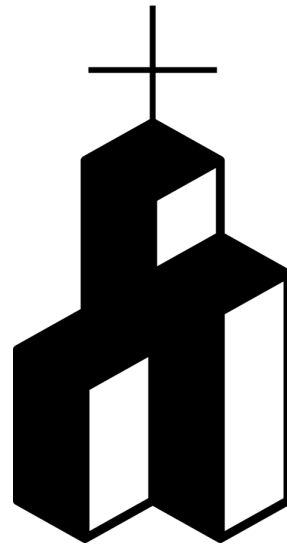
**Pursue Change:** What should I pray for, and what obedient step should I take?

whether by life or by death?

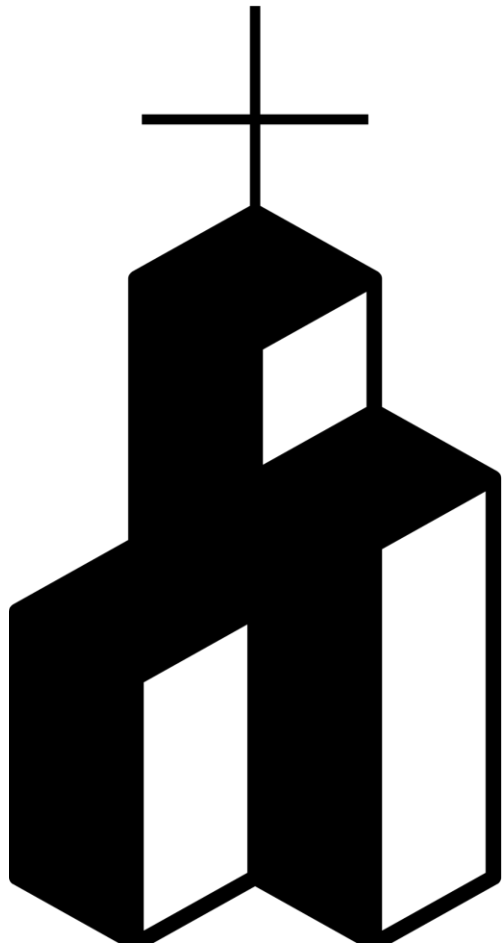
