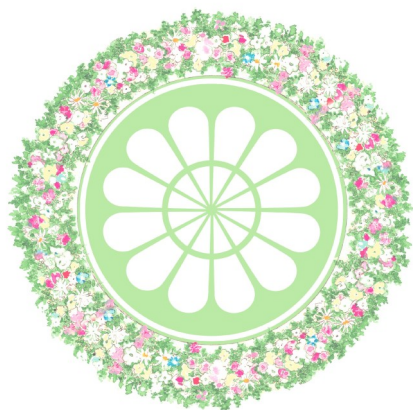

A tax deductible contribution of \$130 is allowable for each individual \$150 ticket.

- *100% of grants are given for project specific, people specific improvements in the lives of the most needy in our community.*
- *100% of grants remain in Collier County to help the neediest in Collier County.*
- *100% of grants are given to help a diverse population of those in need-women, children, families, seniors, infants -throughout various geographic areas of Collier County.*
- *100% of grants are accountable to audits of performance by volunteers on the Grant Commission, 6-12 months after grants are awarded.*
- *0% of grants are given to cover the operating expenses of charity partners chosen to receive an award. Grants are not given for salaries or overhead.*

The Art of Giving raises funds to support programs which improve the lives of the underprivileged in our community. These funds are disbursed through the Archangel Fund for Collier County Charities, which is administered by Trinity-by-the-Cove Episcopal Church, a 501(c)(3) organization. Last year, more than \$143,000 was granted to charities right here in Collier County through our regular grants cycle.
