To reach Houston for Christ and renew lives by grace by directing the spiritual formation of students within the church and outreach to those outside the church so that they worship God, grow in God's grace, and serve in God's mission all for his glory.

About the Position

The Director of Student Ministry will be responsible to oversee programming, staff and volunteers that seek to serve Christ the King's ministry to students in grades six through college.

Responsibilities

- Collaborate with the Associate Pastor for Families and Children's Ministry Director to develop and implement a seamless program of spiritual formation from birth through college.
- Develop a compelling and contagious vision for student ministry that reinforces Christ the King's vision and core values.
- Effectively cast this vision to the congregation with a specific focus on parents.
- Engage with students one-on-one, one-on-a-few, and in small group settings.
- Serve as lead teacher as a part of the Student Ministry team.
- Collaborate with the Associate Pastor for Families to develop and implement a systemic and sustainable curriculum for Student Ministry that dovetails with overall path of discipleship from birth through college.
- Create a culture of warmth and outreach with ministry-wide attention to newcomers.
- Safeguard and instill the philosophy of ministry among staff, parents and volunteers.
- Create a fun and engaging environment where students are welcome and experience the love and grace of Jesus Christ in an age-appropriate manner.
- Promote excellence in ministry through on-going professional development, ministry goal setting and personal spiritual growth.
- Oversee the recruiting, equipping, coaching, and encouraging of volunteers.
- Disciple volunteers and instill Christ the King's philosophy of ministry.
- Pastorally care for volunteers and key lay leaders.

Director of Student Ministry

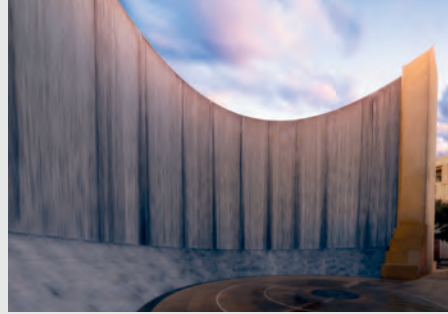
- Track and encourage college students who are members of Christ the King.
- Collaborate with the Associate Pastor for Families to create engaging opportunities for encouragement and discipleship of college students during winter break and summer.
- Collaborate with the Associate Pastor for Families and the Director of Young Adults to “hand-off” college students to the Young Adults Ministry as college seniors return to Houston.
- Develop and maintain effective systems that foster excellence throughout the ministry to include volunteer management, attendance tracking, and key performance measures.
- Supervise the use of physical space allocated to student ministry.
- Oversee the safeguarding of the highest standards of safety.
- Oversee the annual budgeting and ministry planning process.
- Train, oversee and encourage the Student Ministry staff team.
- Ensure the priority of gathered worship personally and among all Student Ministry staff.
- Lead in the hiring of future staff and collaborate in the hiring of Christ the King Fellows assigned to Student Ministry.

Houston was founded on August 30, 1836 by brothers Augustus Chapman Allen and John Kirby Allen on land near the banks of Buffalo Bayou.

Houston is the fourth most populous city in the nation, with an estimated July 2018 population of 2,325,502 (trailing only New York, Los Angeles and Chicago), and is the largest in the southern U.S. and Texas.

145 languages

Greater Houston is the most ethnically diverse metropolitan area in the United States. At least 145 languages are spoken by city residents, and 90 nations have consular representation in the city.

90 nations

The Houston-The Woodlands-Sugar Land Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA) consists of nine counties: Austin, Brazoria, Chambers, Fort Bend, Galveston, Harris, Liberty, Montgomery and Waller and covers 9,444 square miles, an area slightly smaller than Massachusetts but larger than New Jersey.

About Houston

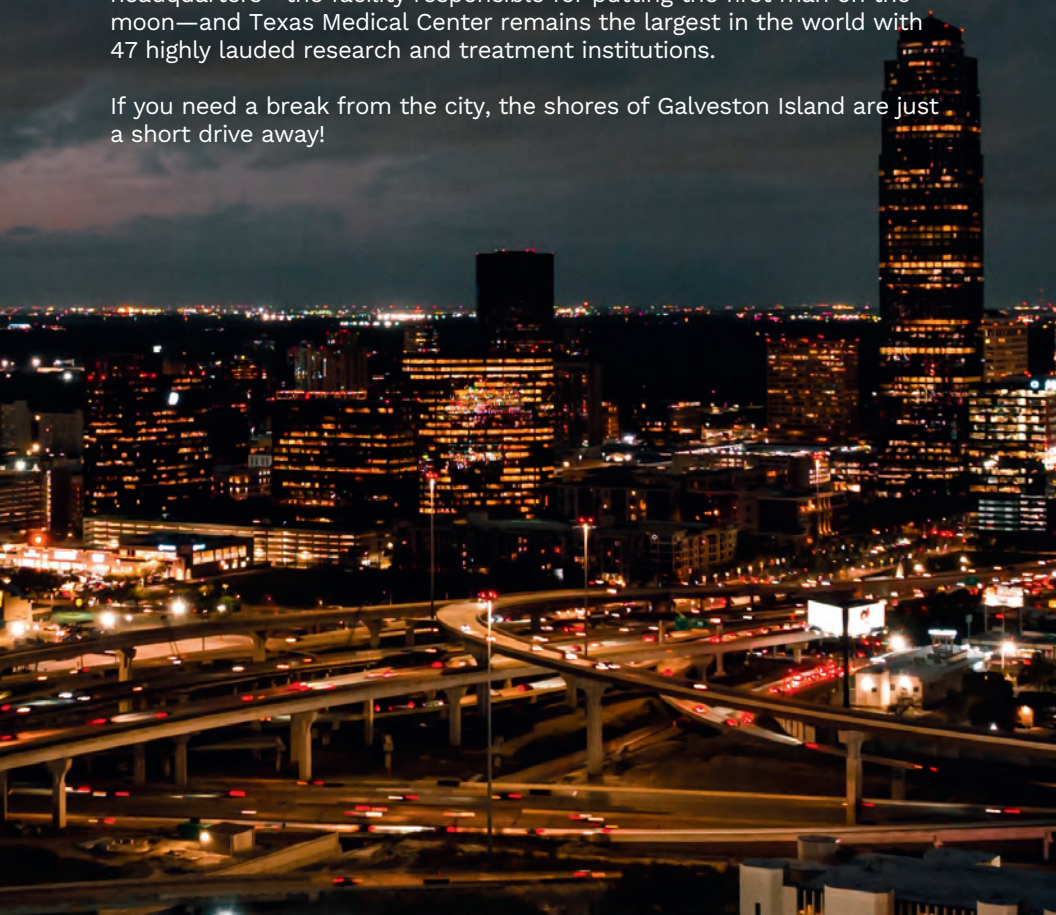
Houston has a diverse sports scene with many professional and college teams, including the Astros, Texans, Rockets, Dynamo, and Dash.

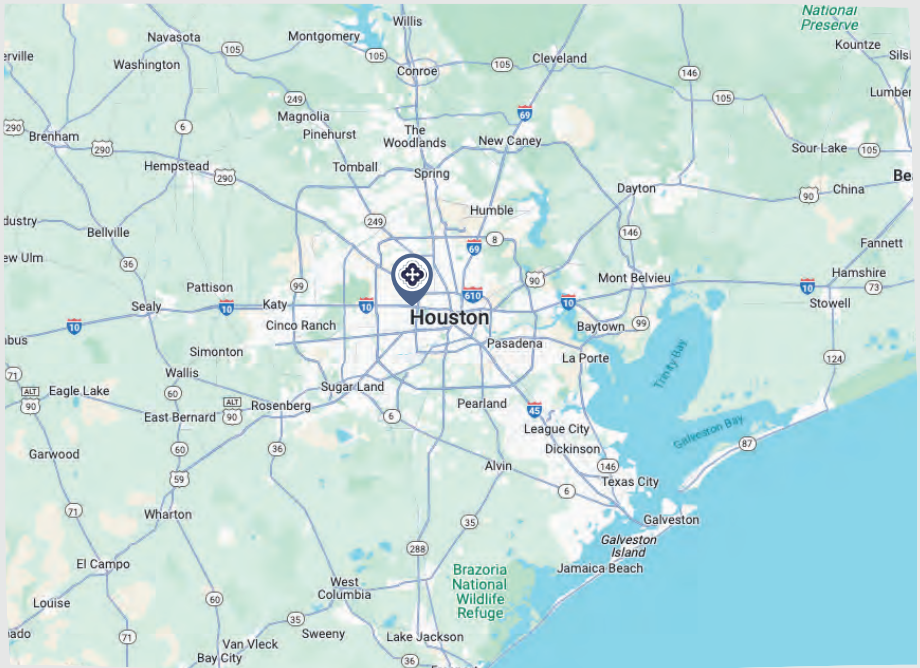
Houston also boasts a thriving professional arts scene, with resident companies in ballet, opera, symphony and theater. The Museum District stakes its claim as the country's fourth-largest, with 18 cultural powerhouses set within blocks of one another.

With 13,000 restaurants representing cuisine from more than 70 countries and American regions, Houston's restaurant scene is as ethnically diverse as its more than 6 million residents. In fact, Houston was named the "newest capital of great food" by Food & Wine and the country's most exciting food city by Tasting Table magazine.

Twenty-five companies on the Fortune 500 list call the Energy Capital of the World home. Aeronautic research is unsurpassed at NASA headquarters—the facility responsible for putting the first man on the moon—and Texas Medical Center remains the largest in the world with 47 highly lauded research and treatment institutions.
