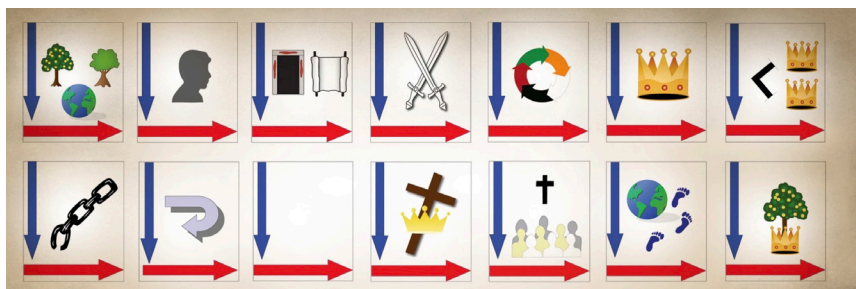

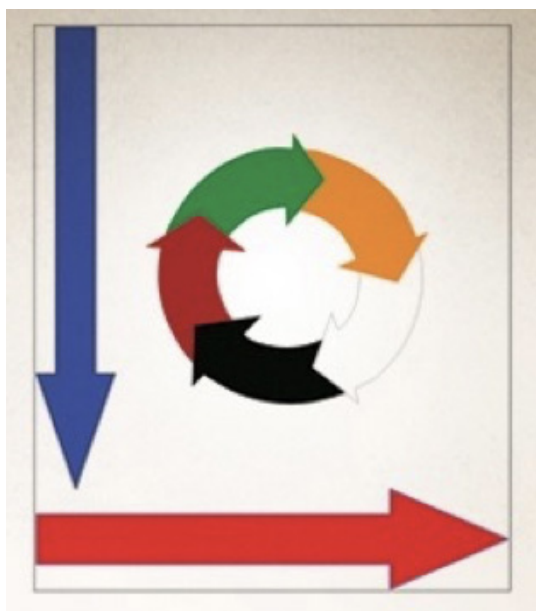
The 14 Era

Structure of the Bible

This year as we read the entire Bible in a year it is our desire that our Church would be equipped to understand and to tell the story of scripture in a succinct and simple way. We will be using the 14 Era Structure of the Bible so that we have a framework for this story. This is one simple tool that helps us remember and share how the entire Bible fits together.

“Assembling the story line of the Bible resembles the assembly of a puzzle. Without the picture on the box cover, you won’t know what you’re building, and you’ll quickly lose interest. Further, without the straight edges and corners you will not have a framework for all the other pieces in the box. The 14 Era graphic of the Bible provides a simple structure that builds the storyline of the Bible.” Each time we enter in to a new era in the story, there will be a descriptive page of what that era entails in our Rooted Journals with an icon that symbolizes that Era.







The Judges Era

We have concluded the Conquest Era and are moving into the Judges Era. The books of Judges and Ruth comprise the Judges Era. After the death of Joshua and the elders, the people of Israel again fail to live according to the law that the Lord had given them. They were God's chosen people set apart to display his character and his glory, but they failed to do so. Each man and woman were determined to do what was right in his or her own eyes and they entered into a repeated cycle of disobedience and failure. In the midst of all the disobedience and failure the story of Ruth reminds us of God's promise to send an eternal king who will bless the nations from the line of Judah.

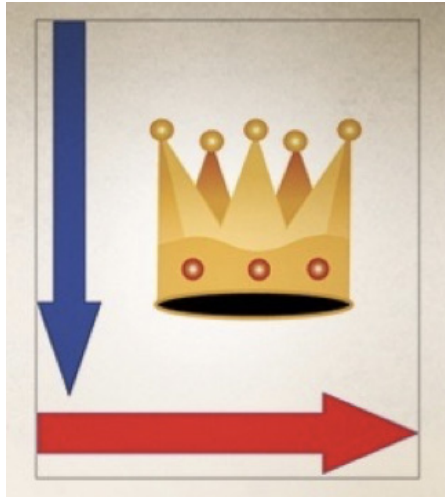



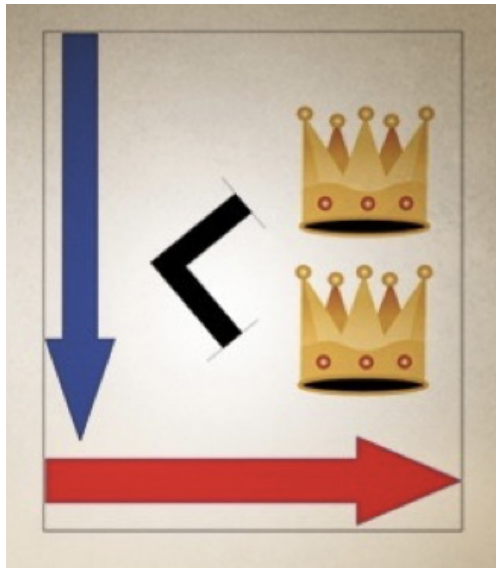

The Divided Kingdom Era

We are now moving from the Kingdom Era to the Divided Kingdom Era. After Solomon dies the nation of Israel divides. Solomon's Son Rehoboam rules over the two southern tribes of Benjamin and Judah. Solomon's former administrator, Jeroboam, becomes king of the ten northern tribes of Israel. Jeroboam disregards the Law and creates his own religious system for the northern tribes. This era will cover portions of several books from the Old Testament, and will take us up to the point when the people of Israel go into captivity.
