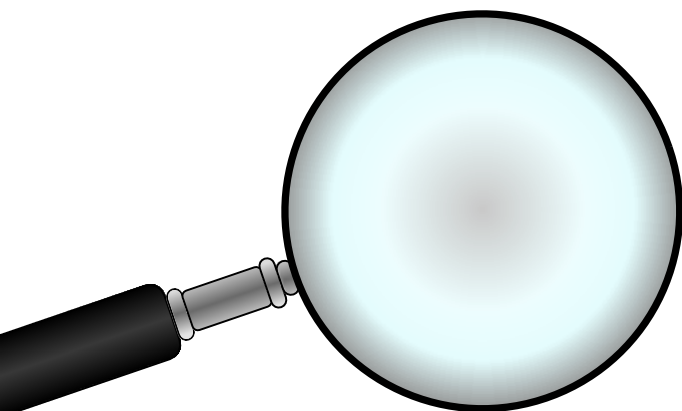




- Discover seeing **Christ** as the Creator of all things who loves you dearly.

Day Campers must be dropped off at **9:00 AM** and picked up at **9:00 PM**.

# What to Expect from Camp

Campers will discover who Jesus is and why we can trust what the Bible says about Him. Throughout the week, they'll explore real reasons the Bible is reliable—looking at how it all fits together, what was happening in history when it was written, and how its promises come true. As they investigate these truths, campers will see that if the Bible is true, then everything it says about Jesus—and about us—is true. With an “explorer” mindset, campers will engage in hands-on activities, outdoor games, and team challenges that bring these ideas to life. Worship will be age-appropriate and reflect what they might experience in a church setting. Along the way, they'll build friendships, make memories, and experience the love of Christ.

## Day Camp



We are offering a day camp experience again this year! These students will be dropped off each morning of camp and must be picked up each evening. They will have the full camp experience minus the overnight stay and late-night activities. All belongings will be kept in a backpack. All campers will be dropped off at **9:00 AM** and picked up by **9:00 PM** by a **pre-approved adult**.

## Overnight Camp



Each session will be limited to 15-20 overnight campers per gender. These campers will stay in the dorms with their Camp Guides. These students will NOT be able to leave camp during their session. They will have a full overnight camp experience. This is a fantastic opportunity for the experienced campers or for those who want to stay with friends.

# Financial and Registration Information

Please turn in your camp fee to the DTBA office or submit online. Fees are \$135 for Grades 1-2, \$150 for Grades 3-4, and \$175 for Grades 5-6. These fees will cover everything the campers need during their camp session. Overnight and Day Campers will have the same fees. Fees and registration are due by June 19. Checks should be payable to Desoto-Tate Baptist Association. Proof of insurance is required. Overnight spots are first come, first serve. (25% savings for 3-4 siblings; contact DTBA for pricing for 5+ siblings)

# What to Bring

### ALL CAMPERS:

- Bible and pencil
- Rain jacket or poncho
- Bug spray
- Flashlight
- Sunscreen
- Small bag/backpack
- Water bottle with first and last name
- Modest clothing + swimming suit
- Flip flops/sandals/water shoes
- Tennis shoes
- Beach towel for pool and water games

### DAY CAMPERS:

- One clean change of clothes each day
- Large backpack with clothes, towel, shoes, etc.  
*(This will not be carried around all day but will go home each day)*

### OVERNIGHT CAMPERS:

- Sleeping bag or bed linens (twin)
- One trash bag for dirty laundry
- Pajamas
- Toiletries (toothpaste/bath items/deodorant)
- Pillow
- TWO changes of clothes for each day of camp.

## Age Requirements

Children must have completed first grade to attend. Campers should know the grade of the session they plan to attend. If a camper would like to attend a session for alternative ages, you must get prior approval from the camp director. For all questions or approval, please call the office at 662.429.5033.

## Mail

Overnight campers will have the opportunity to receive mail each morning. Letters will be handed out as the day begins. Please keep it simple and do not send packages. All mail will be given out prior to the arrival of day campers. Please give your letters to the leader from your church or leave them with camp administrators when you drop off your child at camp. Please clearly list your child's full name on the outside of the letter. Remember, it is best not to tell them how much you miss them. Please encourage them to have a good time at camp.

## Scholarships and Donations

Scholarships are available for those who wish to send their child to camp but are not financially able. If you would like to know more or would like to donate to camp in any way, please contact the DTBA office.

## Refunds

If your child is registered and unable to come to camp, we will reimburse you. Refund requests cannot be made after June 15. Expect a two-week delay in any refund request.
