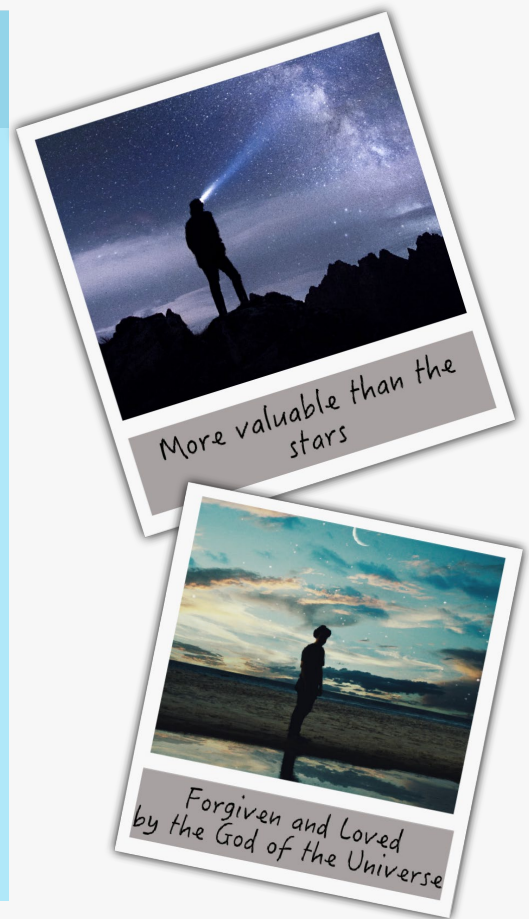
WHAT TO BRING
