#### I Dare You!

"I dare you!" was something we as kids said a lot to each other. Sometimes good, sometimes bad. Whenever someone dares us to do something, it means they want us to do something that's difficult to do.



#### **Harvest of Talents and IDES**

After natural disasters in Northeast India, thousands of hungry people were reached and impacted by sharing rice, chips and other edible items through funds provided by Harvest of Talents and International Disaster Emergency Service (IDES).

In recent months alone we were able to touch the State of Assam, particularly the Dima Hasao and Cachar districts, where landslides and flooding were prevalent. Through our sharing of rice to adults and chips to children in the name



of the resurrected Lord, tears and slogans were everywhere, thanking the good Lord and the services of IDES.

We also served areas like Churachandpur and Noney districts of Manipur where a considerable number of people were buried alive by massive landslides. We were so touched when we saw a number of children calling and waiting for their parents' return.

The political refugees from Myanmar living in a



desperate situation on the borders, also called for help, and with a team of ministers, elders and civil organizations we served them with the essential items they needed most while the refugees sheltered in temporary tents and huts.

We feel so privileged to be able to reach out to these unfortunate sisters and brothers in Christ. Please continue praying for them and for the ministry of IDES and Harvest of Talents.

#### Kerala Christian Mission, Southwest India Felix Matthew reporting:

Onam, the traditional harvest festival, was a great blessing in Kerala. Most areas have major rivers where snake boat races are held. This year our churches handed out around 25.000 tracts to the crowds who came to the various boat race centers. We are hoping and praying that some will respond to the invitation given.

School is back in session and our churches provided school kits and uniforms for 500

underprivileged young people. All of these were sent to our mission church areas to help their outreach in the community. They were well received by the community as well as the invitation for the children to attend extra subject classes on Tuesdays and Thursdays. We have around a total of 225 kids attending these classes.

Our churches held their annual elders and leaders retreat at our mission headquarters with 117 leaders attending. We encourage them to "stand firm on the Word." We will convene another retreat when I visit to introduce what we hope will lead to their seeing the vision of raising their own church planting funds. We hope to set up an entity similar to the old Lincoln Land Evangelistic Association and help them develop a Harvest of Talents/faith promise-type system to think outwardly as a church community.

We are happy to report that Valsa, the wife of James Abraham, the on-site director, is finishing up her chemo for breast cancer, and we are thankful for the progress she is making and the healing that God is providing. Please continue your prayers for more churches to be planted and for Christians to be discipled.
