Returning to Truth

Have you ever been in a hurry and buttoned up a long overcoat with lots of buttons and when you were done, found out that the coat was uneven? What went wrong? We all know what went wrong. When you don't get the first button in the right hole, all the rest are out of sequence too, right?

That's a parable about truth. If the Word of God is not your standard for truth, then, like the overcoat, so many other things in life will be out of whack as well.

Jesus prayed, "Sanctify them in the truth; Thy word is truth." John 17:17

Jesus also said, "And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall set you free." John 8:32

Satan deceived Eve by questioning the truth of God..."Did God really say, 'You will die if you eat from this tree'?" NOTICE - he uses the word "really???" That is a skeptic's attempt to ambush you. "Do you REALLY believe in demons?" Behind this question is the message. "No logical person would believe that?" The best answer: "Well, the Bible says there are demons. So, yes, I believe in demons."

Eve gave the right answer; she came back quoting God's truth. But Satan wasn't done. Satan denied the truth, "You won't surely die," he said. And then he exchanged the truth for a lie. "You will become like God." Eve throws off the truth of God for a deception.

She's not alone. Trends come and go, and everyone—inside and outside the church—are influenced by them. John 1 tells us Jesus came in Grace and Truth. We love the idea of Grace but live in a time of suppressed truth. According to God, truth matters.

In January, we will have a four-week series for young people and adults that explores how God has called us to be a people of Truth. His truth. How God instructs us to be set-apart, nonconformists, separate from our cultural influences and at the same time engage communities with the hope of the gospel. How does that work? Separate yet engaged? I'll show you in January.



GLOBAL IMPACT

The church in Guinea-Bissau, located in West Africa, continues to grow and expand by God's grace and blessing. The work in Guinea-Bissau is currently led by Adriana Lopez and Ana Paula both from Brazil. Ana Paula joined the team this year and writes "my focus is to teach the Bible and give them church planting tools." Here are a few highlights of the work being done.

Each church in Guinea-Bissau is led by a national pastor with an emphasis on evangelism and church planting. Recently two churches joined together to celebrate the baptisms of 21 young people in one day. Additional pastors are needed to lead these churches.

Pray for more pastors and particularly for a new minister for the church at Sao Paulo.



While these ministers are eager to share the love of Christ, they need a strong biblical foundation and leadership development. The Institute for Development and Evangelism, which will help to meet these needs and train additional pastors, finally has a roof so additional building phases and ministry can occur. Hisportic Christian Mission director Tim Shields is leading two short-term mission trips to Guinea-Bissau in February of 2023 where they will be continuing construction on the new Institute.

Pray for the upcoming mission trips and for the ministry training to begin at the Institute.

Development of Christian women, youth, and children is crucial to the work in Guinea-Bissau. Women from churches throughout Guinea-Bissau came together for a conference November 18-20 and enjoyed teaching, fellowship, and sharing of special music and dancing.

Educating children to know God, have a Christian character, and a Biblical worldview is an important component of the work in Guinea-Bissau. Bethel Christian School, in the capital of Bissau, educates and provides breakfast and lunch to 275 children in grades pre-K through 8th grade. The school recently added a second wing and a kitchen and now has electricity as well.

Christians in Cacheu, home of the first Christian Church in Guinea-Bissau, have prayed for a school since 2002. During the summer of 2022, building started on the new Cacheu Christian School. The church's youth group is handling the construction including making their own cement blocks and digging the foundation.

Joaninha, a 7th grade student at Bethel Christian School, shared the following prayer at a teacher training this fall in Guinea-Bissau. "Dear Lord, I want to pray for all the students in our great country that they would have the same opportunity I have to study in a good and godly school where they are not going to be physically beaten or verbally abused. I want to ask that they would have the chance to know and love you. Amen."

Will you pray with Joaninha that the children in Guinea-Bissau, particularly Muslim children, will have the chance to know and love God?
