

Awaken

The article read: "Woman wakes in morgue freezer." Yikes! In Poland, a 91-year-old woman has shocked her family - and public - by waking up in a morgue after being declared dead. Despite 11 hours of cold storage, Janina Kolkiewicz was discovered to be alive and well after mortuary staff detected movements in her body bag. Again . . . YIKES! Sounds like something from a scary movie. The article went on to say it's not that uncommon. Please, let this be uncommon, right?

Yes, Easter is all about a man coming back to life in a tomb. But make no mistake about it, Jesus was certainly dead. There's a huge difference between a mistaken death and a true resurrection. The evidence of his restored life is quite overwhelming. After all he experienced, the flogging, the nails, the spear, he appeared to many not as barely able to stand, but as the picture of strength.

If the resurrection story is true, and the evidences are staggering, then it has the power to change everything. If welcomed, it can cause a great awakening in us. If embraced, it will change us in the most profound ways. Hope is awakened. Joy will be awakened. Our purpose for living and our courage to face tomorrow will all be awakened.

Most of us are either easy risers or slow risers. I wake quickly in the morning. My wife wakes slowly, making the most of a snooze alarm. Our grandchildren are fun to watch after a night at Papa's. Some are quick risers and some are slow risers. If I say to Ben, "Who wants pancakes?" He immediately sits up and moves toward the table. Alex moves much slower. He likes to have his back rubbed as he's waking. He likes to be held a little at first.

Our world is the same when it comes to resurrection awakening. Some of us were quick to accept it. Many are slow. Regardless, once a person wakes up to its truth . . . it changes everything in the most explosive ways. This Easter, we begin a fourweek sermon series titled "AWAKEN." I am most excited about this series! We need this awakening. I need this. This is going to be a great Easter season.
