

When my father passed away, he made sure to hand down a few items to me that he knew were important to me. One item was his old guitar that I first learned to play on. 



Dear Friends.

One of my most favorite encounters with Jesus happens in John Chapter 6. It is a familiar story—the "Feeding of the 5,000." Jesus, surrounded by the great crowd of hungry people, turns to those closest to him and asks what they should do, where could they get food (although Jesus knew all along what He would do). Philip answers quickly, "it would take more than a half year's wages to even buy enough for everyone to have one bite." Every time I read Philip's response I wonder if his tone was indignant about Jesus' request. Whether he was or not, still we see his response is very different than that of Andrew, who was also present. Andrew pipes up and offers that there is a boy with five loaves and two fish, just a kid's lunch. He sees it as a resource but just isn't sure how this small amount could provide a solution, and he asks "how far will it go among so many?" I wonder if Andrew was more searching than Philip, if Andrew is expecting that something will happen, something yet unknown to him, something amazing?

Jesus doesn't disappoint; He blesses the five loaves and two little fish and something truly amazing happens! What seems impossible is completely possible, and not only that, He provides abundantly with more bread than is needed!



In May of 1977, a student from Lincoln Christian College approaching her senior year came to Lincoln Christian Church to "learn the ropes of ministry." She had no idea HOW to do this thing called ministry. It was an Andrew moment--a time to search for an answer of HOW to serve the church. She was embraced by a professional but humble staff who invested in her

deeply over that summer. For her, it was a life changing experience that was formative and laid a foundation for 45 years of ministry. In a very unexpected turn of events in 2006, she, Miss Marcia, returned to that very special place to serve among those who had invested so selflessly.

And so, as I end this leg of the journey, I say thank you for the influence and growth that serving LCC in Children's Ministry over the last sixteen years has afforded me. I thank the leadership, volunteers, families, children and encouraging church family for your trust and support. With Jesus, it has been more than possible to see growth in the lives of many. Like Andrew, I expected that Jesus would do more than I could dream—amazing things. Jesus never disappoints us!

As I move to the next pathway on my personal journey, I am excited for the possibilities the future holds for Lincoln Christian. I am confident that Jesus will continue to provide abundantly and that amazing things will happen as you faithfully follow and trust Him.

Again, my heartfelt thanks for the blessing of serving at Lincoln Christian and prayers for the future in this place.

We treasure the longstanding partnership of our congregation with Dr. T. Lunkim for over 35 years: leading people to Christ through relationship, including Christian education and services through a theological college & seminary, a hospital, an orphanage, the sending of missionaries to Bhutan and Nepal, and spearheading the One Christian Church movement to unite the divided churches among the Kuki people.

We rejoice with Brother Lunkim for the planting of 25 churches and monthly baptism services in the mission fields of Nepal. Fellow Christians are working hard to start Meitei churches for stout Hindus to come forward to receive the Gospel. Please pray for the new converts there and in Assam State. Dr. Lunkim recently dedicated the new Kholunphai Christian Church building in Manipur South, which will serve over 250 congregations!

The 44th Convention of the Kuki Christian Church Manipur convened in January with more than 2,000 delegates from 206 local churches. Dr. Lunkim shared God's Word, focusing on relying on the Lord (Psalm 118:8). The 45th convention of the Kuki Christian Church in Assam convened in February with 1,500 delegates from 56 local churches, highlighting the Church's glorification (Matthew16:18). Dr. Lunkim preached and challenged for renewed commitment to the unbroken church of Christ.

Mission field visits were made in January to Missionary Ajit Dooley (who serves on Majuli Island, the longest floating island in the world, where 14 churches have been planted with around 280 members) and to missionaries in Tripura: "We love KCC and will continue to uphold Restoration beliefs and doctrines; please do not leave us."

Our current mission budget provides a gift of \$300 monthly to KCC. Thank you for joining your Global Impact Team in prayer for our missionaries.

Sharing their professional backgrounds in education, finances, law, business, parenting, and more! This combined experience has led CCC to excel today. We need a strong board at our helm. 
