Adoration of God

- Our God is holy, loving, eternal, and astonishing beyond our comprehension. Take a moment and praise God for these attributes.
- Lord God, I acknowledge you as the Creator of heaven and earth—the giver and sustainer of our lives. May our heart's cry be to glorify you throughout each of our days.

Confession

- Lord, we come before You with honesty. Show me the places in my heart where I have fallen short and give me the courage to name them before You, the only One who can forgive.
- Father, we admit the times we have chosen our way over Yours. Forgive us for the words, thoughts, and actions that have hurt You and others.

Request for Family

- 1 Peter 4:10 instructs us to use whatever gift we have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God's grace in its various forms. Pray with your family for increased understanding of how to live out this verse within your family, then in your neighborhood and the marketplace.
- As you spend time seeking God's face as a family, pray for wisdom in living out 1 John 1:7, "But if we walk in the light, as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus, His Son, purifies us from all sin."

Requests for Church

- May Belle Aire continue to grow in distinctiveness from the world in love and holiness, as we continue to engage with outsiders.
- May we give faithfully of our financial resources and learn to steward our gifts, talents, and time in ways that bring glory to God and enhance His kingdom work.

Requests for Those without Christ

- We acknowledge that God does not want anyone to perish. He desires for all to come to repentance. (2 Peter 3:9) As we pray for non-believers, our hearts, minds, and prayers are aligned with the Father's will and purpose for their lives.
- Pray, believing that in God's perfect timing, the seeds you have sown will take root and flourish.

Requests for Nation
