A TOOL FOR YOUR INDIVIDUAL PRAYER TIME

Adoration of God

- Pray verses from the Lord's Prayer. "Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come, Your will be done in our lives as it is in heaven. We praise Your holiness and glory above all." (Matthew 6:9-10)
- Eternal Father, we adore You, the Creator of all things. Every sunrise, each bird and tree reflects Your perfect handiwork. We worship You, Lord, for Your wisdom and majesty." (Nehemiah 9:6; Revelation 4:11)

Confession

- Pray against pride, being willing to confess immediately if the Holy Spirit convicts you of this sin. Confessing issues of pride allows you to return to a posture of humility, dependence, and obedience before a holy and gracious God. "God resists the proud, but gives grace to the humble." (James 4:6)
- Pray against Anger – God gives us many emotions. Anger is one of those; however, when uncontrolled, it leads to bitterness, harsh words, and even broken relationships. "Let all bitterness, and wrath, and anger, be put away from you." (Ephesians 4:21)

Request for Family

- Ask the Father to send His angels to watch over your family. May they surround your family with protection and guard you wherever you go. "For He will command His angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways." (Psalm 91:11)

- Father, teach my family to be patient with one another. May we have hearts for forgiveness, just as you have modeled Your forgiveness for us. May love be the bond that knits our hearts together. “Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you. And over all these virtues put on love, which binds them all together in perfect unity.” (Colossians 3:13-14)

Requests for Church

- Lord, we ask that You awaken Your church in America, beginning with our church and the churches in our community. Lead us in becoming a strong and lasting light in the darkness. May we stand boldly for truth. “You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden.” (Matthew 5:14)
- Almighty Father, we pray for the spiritual growth of Belle Aire. Deepen our understanding of Your Word and strengthen our commitment to live by it daily in every thought and deed. “But grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.” (2 Peter 3:18)

Requests for Those without Christ
