The Reverend Bill Teate, a long term PPC missionary and executive director emeritus of GTI, was the main speaker at our 2022 Missions Conference. He introduced a 3 year effort to reach the Matang people group in India. As a church, PPC will support this mission outreach over the next 3 years financially and through prayer. GTI is a growing ministry that has developed a 3 year strategy to reach the unreached through a fusion of literacy training, Bible/gospel knowledge and church planting.
