Women's Bible Study: The Gospel of Mark • Wednesdays

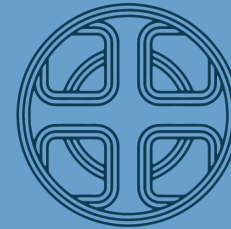
