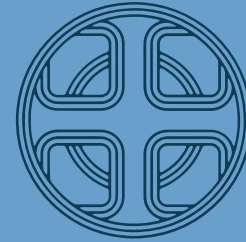
## Joni & Friends Family Retreat • July 30-August 4
