Ministry Role Description

Position:

Pastoral Internship

Summary of Position:

The Pastoral Internship at Proclamation Presbyterian Church provides direct discipleship to a select group of seminary students to develop both their personal character and professional competency. This discipleship is accomplished through a series of rotations in the different ministries of the church. Each quarter, interns will work through a different area of ministry, including church operations, children's and youth ministry, college ministry, congregational care, and evangelism. These rotations will be joined together by an ongoing mentoring relationship with members of the pastoral team that will focus primarily on calling, character, and leadership.

Qualifications:

- Must be a current or recent seminary student.
- A deep love for Christ, the Church, and the gospel; marked by humility and a willingness to learn.
- A desire to pursue full-time pastoral ministry
- General agreement with the Westminster Standards.
- A collaborative and correctable spirit.

Appointment:

Pastoral Interns are appointed by the Session of Proclamation Presbyterian Church.

Key Responsibilities:

1. Discipleship
 - Attend and actively participate in weekly and monthly meetings with members of the pastoral team to develop the interns as future pastoral leaders.
 - Attend and learn from staff and session meetings, as available and appropriate.
2. Teaching
 - Lead and teach across the ministries in the church, including, but not limited to, children's ministry, youth ministry, and adult Sunday School.
3. Visitations
 - Accompany pastoral team members in visiting saints in the hospital and saints at home.
4. Preaching and Worship Leadership
 - Preach approximately 5 sermons, predominantly in the Evening Service.
 - Assist in worship after being trained and developed.
5. Rotations
 - Rotations require the intern to learn how to work in ministry from beginning to end, potentially including, but not limited to, working alongside church administrators, working alongside sextons, greeting and hospitality, service in children's and youth ministry, attending committee meetings, participating in outreach, and observing congregational care.

Expectations & Compensation:

- Internship begins in September and ends the following May.
- \$6,000/year
