Our new technology is live!


The <u>website</u> has a fresh look, complete with new capabilities; we have an app that has all Sunday worship resources and keeps us connected; and a new giving platform on both the <u>website</u> and in the app!

Download the App & Create an Account!

We have our own app! Make sure you download it from your phone's app store by searching for "Asbury Livermore." Once you have downloaded it, create your account!





Here are some general instructions (phone specific instructions are in the images above):

- 1. Open your phone's App Store (either Apple App Store or Google Play Store)
- 2. Search for "Asbury Livermore" (without quotation marks)
- 3. Download Asbury Livermore app (you'll see our logo)
- 4. You did it!



Once you have downloaded the app, create your account!

Why you should create an account

- You'll be able to send and receive messages within the app with other Asbury folks who have an account.
- You can set up online giving for donations or if you need to pay for an event, item, or service.
- You'll (hopefully, eventually) be able to register your attendance at worship with a single tap!

How to create your account:

- 1. Open the Asbury app and tap on the icon with three lines in the top left corner
- 2. Tap "Log In or Sign Up."
- 3. Choose which method you want to use to create your account.
 - 3a. "Continue with Apple" use your Apple ID (iPhones only), then you're done!
 - 3b. "Continue with Google" use your Google account info, then you're done!

- 3c. "Continue with Email" use your email address to create an account, then proceed to Step 4
- 4. Tap "Create an account."
- 5. Enter your name, email address, and create a password. Then tap "Create account" and you're done!

Children's Choirs Resume September 18th!

Sundays from 11:30am - 12:30pm Starting Sunday, September 18th

Save the date for the return of Children's Choir! The choirs meet after Labor Day in September and end their season the 1st Sunday in June with "Music Celebration Sunday". Each of the children's choirs sing in service every five weeks, plus various performances throughout the year.

Cherub Choir (K-2nd grade) has a fun and relaxed time - sharing, song teaching, pitch training, notation, tempo, and learning a song about every 4-6 weeks. The rehearsals usually end with an interactive game or a book, then close with Joys & Concerns and a short prayer. Contact Sharon Gach for more information.

Youth Choir is for students in grades 6th -12th and meets every Sunday from 11:30am - 12:30pm. Choir sings in service once a month.

Youth Choir gives students the opportunity to practice singing together in a group, working more on 2-4 part harmony with the potential for more and solos. Some basic music theory is taught along with proper breathing technique. The Youth Choir also gets to put on a musical once a year in the early spring, giving youth the opportunity to sing, act, and possibly do set design. Youth Choir at Asbury is designed to be fun and give students the chance to sing together when it may not be possible to do so through regular school or during the week.

All are welcome - the Youth Choir is a safe space for those that are looking. We hope to see you soon!
