

Topic: What is Supportive Housing?

The task force on tiny homes has been researching what "supportive housing" means in terms of possibly building tiny homes at Asbury. La Familia, a local social services agency, will talk to us about what services they might provide to the residents if we decide to build the homes. We

Asbury Kitchen Etiquette: Part 2

Hi Asburyites! Here are some more simple guidelines to make the kitchen function well for everyone who uses it.

- 1. Please empty all trash cans after your event. Trash can liners are in the pantry cupboard, and the key to the green waste and trash areas is hanging by the back door.
- 2. Please **scrape** food off of plates into the green waste before washing them. Try NOT to use the garbage disposal (the reason will become obvious).
- 3. If you use the garbage disposal, you will need to clean the drain and dump the partially ground up food into the green waste. Otherwise it will start to rot in the floor drain and stink up the kitchen, and other users and the facility manager will not be very happy with you!
- 4. If you don't know how to use the dishwasher, please make arrangements with the facility manager for training. It's really easy!
- 5. Please let the facility manager know when anything needs to be reordered (dishwasher supplies, coffee supplies, paper plates, paper towels, etc.) BEFORE it runs out! You can use <u>text</u> or <u>email</u>
