Tiny Homes at Asbury: Info Session TODAY

TODAY (Wednesday, October 19th) 6-7pm in the Asbury chapel

Topic: What is Supportive Housing?

The task force on tiny homes has been researching what "supportive housing" means in terms of possibly building tiny homes at Asbury. La Familia, a local social services agency, will talk to us about what services they might provide to the residents if we decide to build the homes. We have also invited some people who have experienced homelessness to share their stories with us.

Asbury and Fertile GroundWorks are hosting a pilot compost hub for the City of Livermore to help them comply with a new state law, that says they either have to use it on municipal property or give it to the residents. Lucky for us, we are giving it away. It is made from our green bins contents.

We are asking folks to come to the hub during our volunteer hours, (9am to 12noon on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Saturday mornings, and 3pm to 6pm on Friday afternoon). The city is asking that you fill out their survey form too.

You can bring your own containers, truck, or borrow a coffee bean bag(s) to transport your compost home. Looking forward to seeing the Asbury gardeners out at the Compost hub soon.
