## Sharing the Gospel Acts 3:11-26

1. Discuss the \_\_\_\_\_ for God
  - v. 11 - *While he clung to Peter and John, all the people, utterly astounded, ran together to them in the portico called Solomon's. (12) And when Peter saw it, he addressed the people*
  - A. Supernatural confirms a \_\_\_\_\_ Being = God
  - B. Creation requires a \_\_\_\_\_ = God
  - C. Complexity reveals a \_\_\_\_\_ = God
2. Direct the discussion \_\_\_\_\_
  - v. 12 - *...“Men of Israel, why do you wonder at this, or why do you stare at us, as though by our own power or piety we have made him walk?*
  - v. 13a - *The God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, the God of our fathers*
3. Explain \_\_\_\_\_
  - v. 13a - *...glorified his servant Jesus (14) ...the Holy and Righteous One*
  - A. *His servant* = \_\_\_\_\_
  - B. *Jesus* = Jehovah is \_\_\_\_\_
  - C. *Holy and Righteous One* = God, the \_\_\_\_\_
4. Address \_\_\_\_\_
  - v. 13b-15a - *whom you delivered over and denied in the presence of Pilate, when he had decided to release him. But you denied the Holy and Righteous One and asked for a murderer to be granted to you, and you killed the Author of life*
5. Present the \_\_\_\_\_
  - v. 15b - *whom God raised from the dead. To this we are witnesses.*
  - v. 16 - *And his name-by faith in his name-has made this man strong whom you see and know, and the faith that is through Jesus has given the man this perfect health in the presence of all.*
  - v. 17 - *“And now, brothers, I know that you acted in ignorance, as did also your rulers.*
  - v. 18 - *But what God foretold by the mouth of all the prophets, that his Christ would suffer, he thus fulfilled.*

6. Conclude: \_\_\_\_\_ -  
and believe in the Lord Jesus Christ. When you do...  
*v. 19 - Repent therefore, and turn back*
- A. You will be granted \_\_\_\_\_.  
*v. 19 - that your sins may be blotted out*
- B. You will be given the \_\_\_\_\_.  
*v. 20 - that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord, and that he may send the Christ appointed for you, Jesus*
- C. You will be delivered from \_\_\_\_\_.  
*v. 26 - God, having raised up his servant, sent him to you first, to bless you by turning every one of you from your wickedness."*
