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2. \_\_\_\_\_ kept Caleb moving forward.

**Application questions:** What assignment has God given me? What kingdom difference can I make today? How am I fulfilling it? \_\_\_\_\_

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3. \_\_\_\_\_ kept Caleb faithful while waiting on God's timing.

**Application questions:** Am I content with the role God has given me? Am I celebrating the success of others or secretly resenting it? Am I faithfully serving while I wait for God's promises to unfold? \_\_\_\_\_
