Discussion Questions

1. Daily Spirit Formation

- What examples of spiritual legacy have impacted your life personally?
- Why is consistency more important than occasional spiritual moments?
- What are you currently modeling to those around you?

2. Fruit Shows Transformation

- Why do people often focus more on gifts than fruit?
- Which fruit of the Spirit do you feel God is developing most in your life right now?
- How does spiritual fruit strengthen your influence and testimony?

3. Spirit-Led Living

- Why do believers sometimes separate “church life” from everyday life?
- What would it look like for your daily routines to become Spirit-led?
- How can you become more aware of the Holy Spirit throughout the week?

LIVING IT OUT

The Holy Spirit forms legacy through everyday faithfulness. This week, practice consistency, spiritual awareness, and intentional surrender so your life reflects the fruit and leadership of the Holy Spirit.

1. **Daily Prayer:** Spend 5 minutes each day praying: “*Holy Spirit, form Your character in me today.*” Then, choose one fruit of the Spirit to intentionally practice daily.
2. **Daily Spirit-Led Living:** Invite the Holy Spirit into one normal routine each day: Parenting, Work, Conversations, Decisions. Pause and ask: “*Holy Spirit, how do You want to lead me here?*”
