This week we saw Jesus encounter a fig tree that looked alive but had no fruit. The moment reminds us God is not looking for appearance, but for genuine fruit that grows from a life truly connected to Christ.

Discussion Questions

1. Appearance Is Not the Same as Fruit

(Mark 11:12–14)

- What is the difference between looking spiritually alive and actually being spiritually healthy?
- In what areas of life can fruit become the clearest evidence of a genuine relationship with Christ?
- How can we guard against focusing on outward appearance instead of inward transformation?

2. Fruit Comes From Relationship, Not Religion

(John 15:5)

- What does Jesus mean when He says we must “remain” in Him to bear fruit?
- What spiritual practices help you stay connected to Christ throughout the week?
- What warning signs might indicate that someone is becoming spiritually busy but relationally distant from God?

3. Fruitlessness Reveals a Deeper Root Issue (Mark 11:20–21)

- Why do you think the tree withered from the roots rather than from the outside first?
- What kinds of “root issues” can slowly lead to spiritual fruitlessness in a believer’s life?
- How does returning to intimacy with Christ restore spiritual fruit?

Living It Out

This week, as you think about the fruitless fig tree, ask the Holy Spirit to guide you and write down what the Holy Spirit reveals.

- ***Where might you see “leaves without fruit” in your spiritual life?***
- ***What step can you take this week to stay more connected to Jesus?***
- ***What fruit of the Spirit do you sense God wanting to grow in your life right now?***
