This past Sunday, we saw that the resurrection of Jesus is not just something we celebrate—it's something we live. Because Christ rose, we are called to walk in new life, leaving behind old patterns and stepping fully into our new identity in Him.

Discussion Questions

1. New Identity (Who You Are Now)

- Paul says we were “buried with Christ.” What does that mean for your old identity and past life?
- Why do you think it's difficult for believers to fully embrace being a “new creation”?
- What are some old labels, thoughts, or identities you may still be holding onto that God is asking you to release?

2. New Direction (How You Now Live)

- Colossians 3:1 tells us to “set your sights on things above.” What does that look like practically in your daily life?
- What is one area where you feel tempted to go back to old patterns instead of moving forward?
- How does changing your focus (what you think about, consume, or prioritize) begin to change your direction?

3. New Standard (How You Make Decisions)

- What does it mean that your life is now “hidden with Christ in God”?
- How do you personally struggle with living based on feelings instead of truth?
- In what areas of your life is God inviting you to raise your standard to reflect your new life in Christ?

LIVING IT OUT

Resurrection life is not automatic—it is practiced daily. This week, ask the Holy Spirit to help you walk in your new identity, adjust your direction, and live by a new standard rooted in Christ.

- ***Step 1: Release the Old*** - Identify one habit, mindset, or pattern that needs to stay buried. Pray daily: “Lord, help me leave this behind.”
- ***Step 2: Refocus Your Direction*** - Choose one intentional action this week: Spend time in Scripture daily, Replace negative thinking with truth, Begin your day with prayer
- ***Step 3: Raise Your Standard*** - Before making decisions this week, ask: “Does this reflect who I am in Christ?”
