Business Meeting

There will be a special called Business meeting on Sunday, April 19th, following the evening prayer service to discuss the following motions:

1) A motion by the Building and Grounds Committee to reseal the parking lot at a total cost of \$10,225.00, which includes resealing of parking lot, striping lines, painting visitor and handicap parking spaces, and a 25% discount given, by East Coast Seal Coating & Striping.

2) A motion by the Finance Committee to transfer \$15,000.00 from the net fund to the Designated Building Fund to pay for the parking lot improvements and leaving additional money not used for the project in the designated fund.

\$153,964.44 amount in the net fund as of 2/28/26

The net fund is money remaining from an accumulation of income for offerings minus expenses for line items included in the budget. Designated funds are not included in this amount.

3) A motion by the Deacon Body to establish a committee to oversee and distribute a new fund called the **Angel's Closet Foundation Fund**. Calvary has received a generous \$20,000 donation from the former Angel's Closet organization, given with the intention of meeting a wide range of needs for children, youth and families within both our church and the surrounding community. This committee will ensure that the fund is managed wisely and used in a manner that honors the heart and mission behind this gift. The individual members of this committee will be approved at a future business meeting.
