and goes until 10:20.

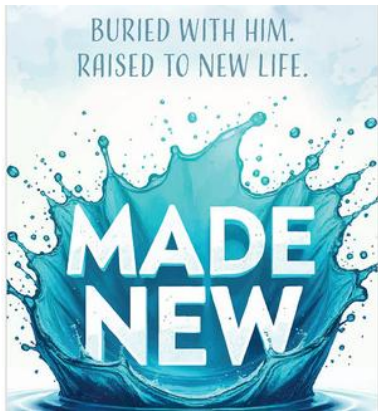
- ♥ Elementary kids go to the

Congratulations also go to Cody Stotzer who was baptized after services the previous Sunday. And to his wife Jordan who placed membership here.



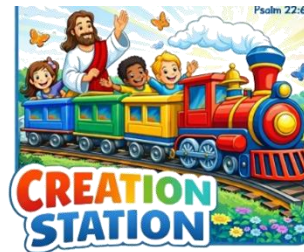
We welcome Bob and Barb Strobel to the Louisville Church family. They placed membership with us last Sunday.

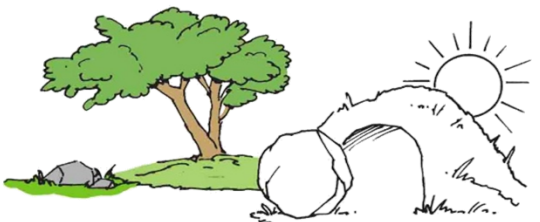
