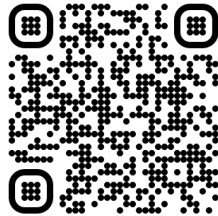

How People Change

The Gospel of Jesus Christ promises a changed heart, but what is the heart and how does God lead us into change? How People Change (HPC) looks at what is at the heart of who we are in suffering, conflict, our highs and lows, and how the Gospel relates to all of it. Paul David Tripp and Tim Lane explain how true transformation and lasting change is possible only in Christ.

When: Tuesdays starting March 6 at 6:30pm, ending at 8:15pm. Classes run for 11 weeks.

Where: Gibbsville Church; N3145 State Road 32; Sheboygan Falls, WI 53085. People from any church are welcome.

Format: We'll start most nights in small groups for 45 minutes to discuss the workbook material from the previous week, then we'll watch a 20-30 minute video teaching by Paul Tripp or Tim Lane, and finish with a 20-30 minute large group discussion and expansion on what we covered. We'll have a reading and workbook assignment to do during the week -- it tends to fit well with regular devotional/quite-time reading.

Leadership/Materials: HPC has been developed by the Christian Counseling and Educational Foundation (CCEF), one of the world's top providers for resources for heart change and deeper discipleship in the church. Tony Beach (from Redemption Counseling Ministries) developed this expanded version of this class that he has been leading churches in the region for the last four years. He will be leading our classes in partnership with the pastors from Gibbsville Church and Bethel Orthodox Presbyterian Church (Tony will lead 2/3 of the classes). Cost: \$35 (scholarships available), checks are payable to your church. This covers the book cost and part of the cost for Tony to lead the class.

How to Join In: Sign up on the "Sign Up Sheet" including your email and deliver a check for \$35 to your church. Then pick up a copy of the book *How People Change*. You can start in on the first three chapters of the book right away – these are the introductory reading we ask everyone to do before the first class on March 6.

Challenge Sunday — Sunday, 4/16

If you think it's all about money and filling out pledge cards, you will be pleasantly surprised. The "challenge" of Challenge Sunday will be this: Be still. Listen expectantly. Ask boldly. Obey humbly. We will not talk about equal giving but, rather, equal sacrifice.

Prayer Event — Saturday, 4/22 to Sunday, 4/23

Prayer is the key. We will pray non-stop for 24 hours asking God to help us reach our goal and to bless our lives. Please sign up to pray for one or more 15-minute time slots. A sign-up sheet will be available at the South entrance information desk.

Commitment Sunday — Sunday, 4/23

On this day we will turn in our sealed Commitment Cards. This will be a time of commitment, sacrifice, and faith. We will have the opportunity to invest in something larger than ourselves — something that will outlast our lives on this earth.

Celebration Sunday — Sunday, 5/7

We all have 10,000 reasons to praise the Lord for His goodness. On Celebration Sunday, we will announce the total amount committed in faith toward our project. Our goal is \$1 million. We believe that we can reach this amount with God's help. Whatever the result, we want to give God all the praise and glory!
