Bell Choir

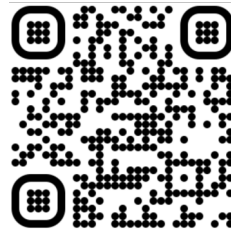

PRAYER SUNDAY

ADVANCE CHALLENGE MEETINGS
