God wants you to know that the Great Day of the Lord will bring two very different realities:

- Pure judgement for the non-believer (Malachi 4:1).  
The day of the Lord will be a day when God finally brings justice. Evil, arrogance, and rebellion against Him will not go unanswered. God will set things right.
- Pure joy for the believer (Malachi 4:2-6).  
For those who fear the Lord, that same day will bring healing, restoration, and joy. God's people will experience the fullness of His goodness and victory over evil.

Be sure to stop by the VBS board in the back of church for more details and to see how you can help with our donation needs. We can't wait to journey with you!


