PRAY, PRAY, PRAY!

The next 24 hours is devoted to prayer. Whether you participate at church or at home - PRAISE God for His faithfulness, ASK for His blessing on our church family, community, and world, SEEK his will for the building project, and then WATCH Him work! TO GOD BE THE GLORY!



Notes:

Remember and rejoice in the character of God.

Reflect and meditate on the character of God: he is all powerful, all knowing, never-changing, ever-present, full of loving-kindness, mercy and grace toward all who call on his name.

Psalm 27:1-2

1 The LORD is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The LORD is the stronghold of my life; of whom shall I be afraid? 2 When evildoers assail me to eat up my flesh, my adversaries and foes, it is they who stumble and fall.

Pray for the "One More" campaign. Ask that God's will would be done and that there would be in unity the church.

Luke 15:3-7

³ Then Jesus told them this parable:
⁴ "Suppose one of you has a hundred
sheep and loses one of them. Doesn't he
leave the ninety-nine in the open country
and go after the lost sheep until he finds
it? ⁵ And when he finds it, he joyfully puts
it on his shoulders ⁶ and goes home. Then
he calls his friends and neighbors
together and says, 'Rejoice with me; I
have found my lost sheep.' ⁷ I tell you that
in the same way there will be more
rejoicing in heaven over one sinner who
repents than over ninety-nine righteous
persons who do not need to repent.

Pray about your specific fears.

Express your fears, anxieties, and concerns to the Lord. Pour out your heart to him. Seek his face and <u>ask for</u> him to hide you in his shelter.

Psalm 27:3-5

3 Though an army encamp against me, my heart shall not fear; though war arise against me, yet I will be confident. 4 One thing have I asked of the LORD, that will I seek after: that I may dwell in the house of the LORD all the days of my life, to gaze upon the beauty of the LORD and to inquire in his temple. 5 For he will hide me in his shelter in the day of trouble; he will conceal me under the cover of his tent; he will lift me high upon a rock.

Pray for our community and world.

Pray for the needs of the world around you: family members, neighbors, medical workers, law enforcement, and governing officials. Ask the Lord to sustain, provide, and guide. Ask him to give his people endurance, wisdom, and hope.

1 Timothy 2:1

1 First of all, then, I urge that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and thanksgivings be made for all people, for kings and all who are in high positions, that we may lead a peaceful and quiet life, godly and dignified in every way.

Pray for those who do not know the Lord.

Consider those in your life who do not know the Lord. Pray that they would seek the Lord. Ask the Lord to open their eyes, ears, minds, and hearts to the truth of his Word. Pray that they would turn to the Lord and find salvation, refuge, and help.

Psalm 27:8-10

8 You have said, "Seek my face." My heart says to you, "Your face, LORD, do I seek."
9 <u>Hide not</u> your face from me. Turn not your servant away in anger, O you who have been my help. Cast me not off; forsake me not, O God of my salvation! 10 For my father and my mother have forsaken me, but the LORD will take me in.

Praise God that he welcomes and hears our prayers.

Psalm 10:17

17 O LORD, you hear the desire of the afflicted; you will strengthen their heart; you will incline your ear.

Psalm 50:15

15 Call upon me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you shall glorify me.

Pray for healing for the sick, and those suffering from physical, spiritual, and emotional issues. Remember those who are shut-in.

1 Peter 5:7

7 Casting all your anxieties on him, because he cares for you.

Galatians 6:2

2 Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ.

Pray for our church, specifically our pastors, elders, deacons, teachers, worship leaders, and ministry teams. Ask that the Lord would refresh and encourage these leaders as they serve.

1 Thessalonians 5:25

25 Brothers and sisters, pray for us.

Pray that the gospel message would be boldly proclaimed and that many people would come to know Jesus and that our church would continue to preach the gospel in truth and without compromise.

Ephesians 6:19-20

19 [Pray] also for me, that words may be given to me in opening my mouth boldly to proclaim the mystery of the gospel, for which I am an ambassador in chains, that I may declare it boldly, as I ought to speak.

Pray that your heart would be open to commitment Sunday.

2 Corinthians 9:7

⁷ Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver. Thank God that he is sovereign. Thank God for his faithfulness to Gibbsville Church and for the generations of faithful believers who have gone before us.
