Bell Choir

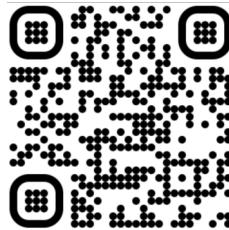

Assistant Secretary

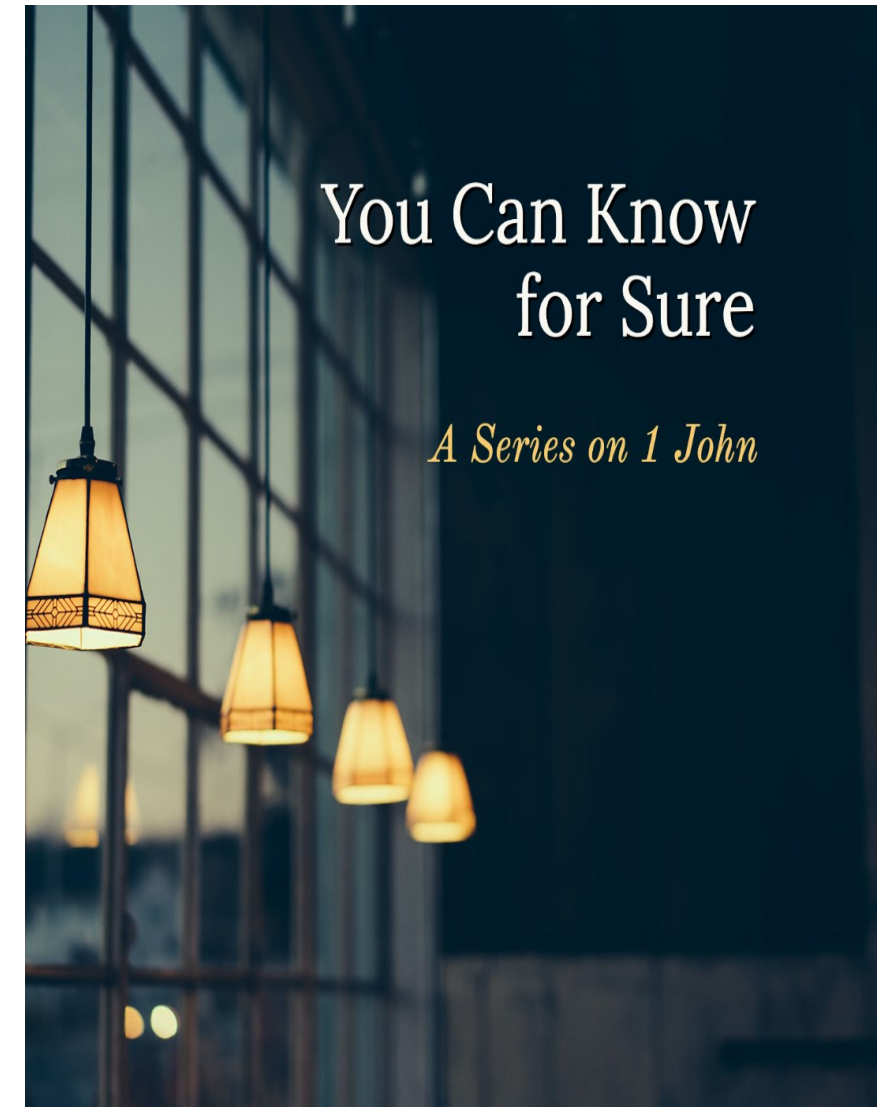
