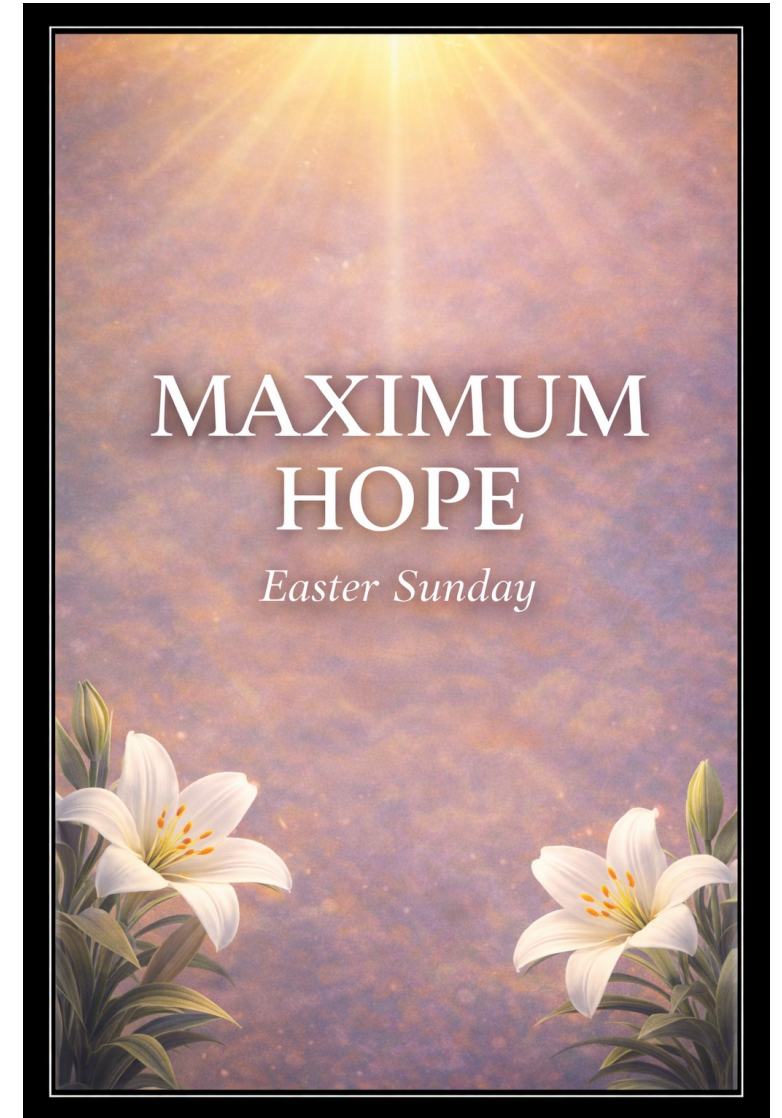
Vacation Bible School—Everyone is invited!
