Join us on Sunday, September 13, as we kick off a new year of Sunday School for children preschool through 8th grade!

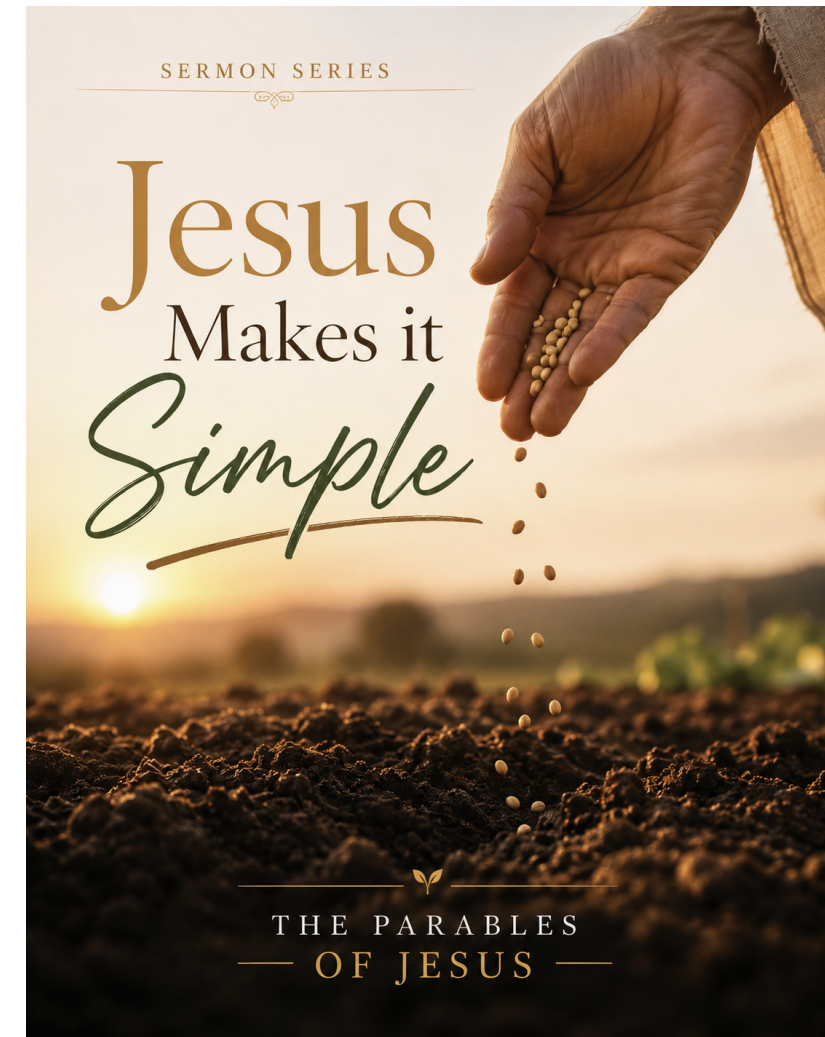
