Sunday School Registration

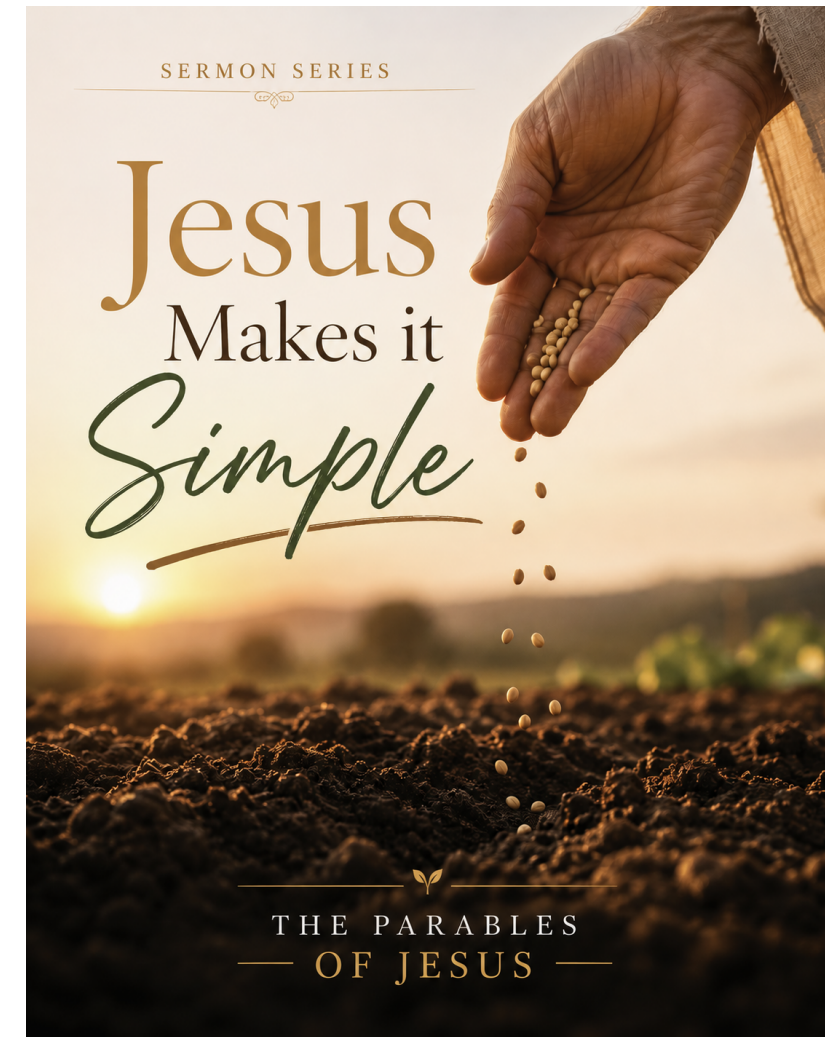
