Mission Statistics:

- There are over 400,000 missionaries operating worldwide.
- Of those, approximately 140,000 of them are Protestant missionaries.
- Around 64,000 of the Protestant missionaries come from the United States, and 76,000 from other countries.
- India, Pakistan, Indonesia, China, and Japan have the highest populations of unreached people.
- Roughly 1,636 languages still need Bible translation.

Sheboygan Warming Center Donations

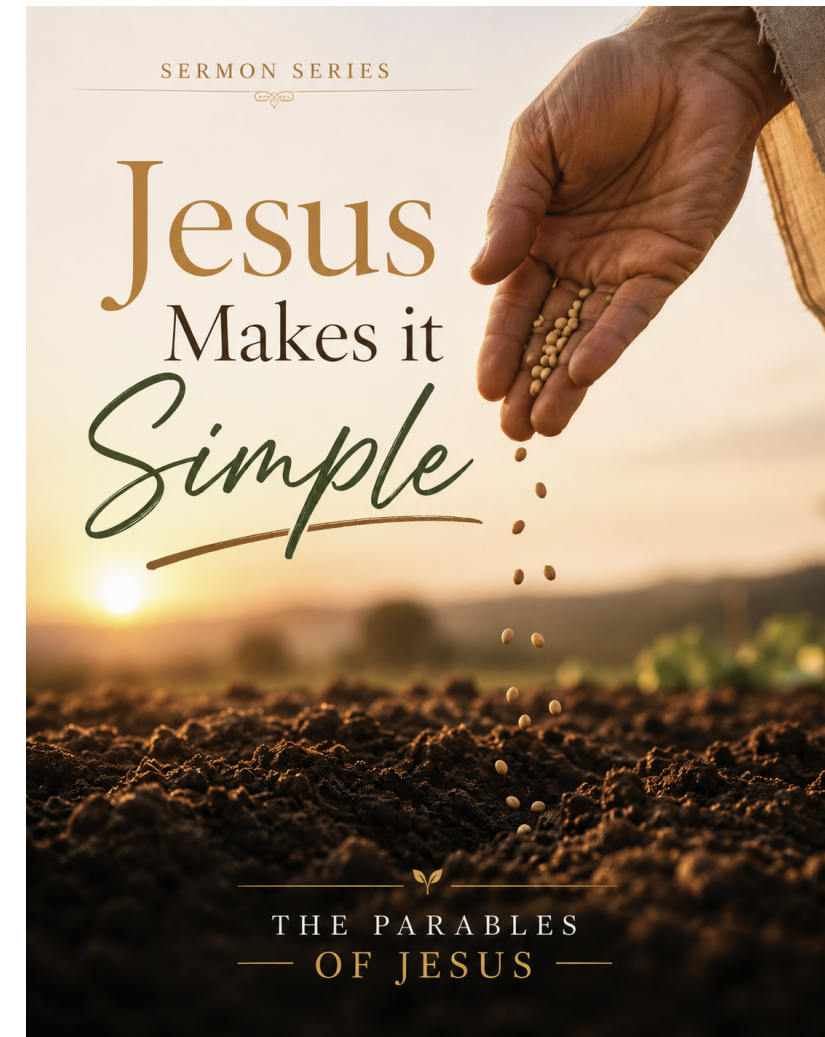
