

Scripture-Based Prayers for Thriving Marriages

1. A Prayer for Christ to Be the Center of Our Marriage

Scripture: Ecclesiastes 4:12; Colossians 3:17

Prayer:

Heavenly Father, we acknowledge that our marriage belongs to You. Help us build our home upon the foundation of Jesus Christ. May every decision, conversation, and goal bring glory to Your name. When difficulties come, remind us that a cord of three strands is not quickly broken. Strengthen our relationship as we walk together with You each day. Amen.

2. A Prayer for Love

Scripture: 1 Corinthians 13:4–8

Prayer:

Lord, teach us to love as You have loved us. Make our love patient when we are frustrated, kind when we are tired, humble when we succeed, and forgiving when we are hurt. Remove selfishness, envy, pride, and resentment from our hearts. May our love endure through every season because it is rooted in Your everlasting love. Amen.

3. A Prayer for Husbands

Scripture: Ephesians 5:25–30

Prayer:

Father, strengthen husbands to love their wives as Christ loved the church. Give them servant hearts, spiritual courage, and unwavering integrity. 11. A Prayer During Conflict

20. A Prayer of Commitment

Scripture: Psalm 37:5; Romans 12:1
