Begin With Prayer

Forgiveness

- 1. The greatest blessing of following Christ is the relationship we get to have with God, rather than just the gifts He gives to us. This means we are forgiven.
 - Why do we need to be forgiven?
 - What hope do we have if we are not forgiven in Christ? Why?

Falling Into Sin

- 1. Why should we avoid causing others to fall into sin? What does Luke 11:37-52 have to say about this?
- 2. How should we respond when a brother or sister falls into sin?
- 3. Someone read Galatians 6:1-10. How should we support one another?
 - What warning do you see in verse 1?
 - What does verse 2 say that we fulfill?
 - How can you be a generous forgiver?



Roots Of Bitterness

- 1. Pastor Matt gave the imagery of the mulberry tree. It has an extensive root system.
 - What kinds of things can take root in our hearts if we choose not to forgive others?
 - What kind of change takes place in the heart if one recognizes they have been forgiven in Christ?

Acts Of Worship

- 1. Someone read Luke 7:36-50
 - What did the woman do in this passage?
 - How did the Pharisees react?
 - What did Jesus recognize about the woman's actions?

Who Will Love More?

- 1. In the parable that Jesus gives in Luke 7, who does it say that would love more?
 - What is faith's response?
