
Good Stuff To Know

Embracing Post Traumatic Growth

1. Acknowledge The Trauma.

- *For my people have done two evil things: They have abandoned me— the fountain of living water. And they have dug for themselves cracked cisterns that can hold no water at all!*

—Jeremiah 2:13 (NLT)

- *The woman said, “I know that Messiah” (called Christ) “is coming. When he comes, he will explain everything to us.” Then Jesus declared, “I, the one speaking to you— I am he.”*

—John 4:25-26 (NIV)

2. Get In The Well.

- *For the law was given through Moses; grace and truth came through Jesus Christ.*

—John 1:17 (NIV)

- *For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him.*

—John 3:16-17 (NIV)

3. Let The Healing Begin.

- *Is anyone among you sick? Let them call the elders of the church to pray over them and anoint them with oil in the name of the Lord. And the prayer offered in faith will make the sick person well; the Lord will raise them up. If they have sinned, they will be forgiven.*

—James 5:14-15 (NIV)

- *He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds.*

4. Start Growing.

Follow Through Step #44:

** If you need help, ask for it. Find a safe person to talk to. Bring your trauma to light. And start growing. **
