Later, Jesus appeared again to the disciples beside the Sea of Galilee. This is how it happened...

—John 21:1 (NLT)

All of this is a gift from God, who brought us back to himself through Christ. And God has given us this task of reconciling people to him. For God was in Christ, reconciling the world to himself, no longer counting people's sins against them. And he gave us this wonderful message of reconciliation.

—2 Corinthians 5:18-19 (NLT)

3 Signs Of Reconciliation:

1. Everybody's Welcome.

- *Several of the disciples were there— Simon Peter, Thomas (nicknamed the Twin), Nathanael from Cana in Galilee, the sons of Zebedee, and two other disciples.*

—John 21:3 (NLT)

- *For Christ himself has brought peace to us. He united Jews and Gentiles into one people when, in his own body on the cross, he broke down the wall of hostility that separated us... Christ reconciled both groups to God by means of his death on the cross, and our hostility toward each other was put to death.*

—Ephesians 2:14-16 (NLT)

- *So accept each other just as Christ has accepted you; then God will be glorified.*

—Romans 15:7 (NLT)

2. Nobody's Perfect.

- *When Simon Peter heard that it was the Lord, he... jumped into the water, and headed to shore. The others stayed with the boat and pulled the loaded net to the shore... When they got there, they found*

breakfast waiting for them— fish cooking over a charcoal fire, and some bread.

—John 21:7-9 (NLT)

- *Why do you fight and argue with each other? Isn't it because you are full of selfish desires that fight to control your body?*

—James 4:1 (CEV)

- *Make allowance for each other's faults, and forgive anyone who offends you. Remember, the Lord forgave you, so you must forgive others.*

—Colossians 3:13 (NLT)

3. Anything's Possible.

- *After breakfast Jesus asked Simon Peter, "Simon son of John, do you love me more than these?" "Yes, Lord," Peter replied, "you know I love you." "Then feed my lambs," Jesus told him. Jesus repeated the question: "Simon son of John, do you love me?" "Yes, Lord," Peter said, "you know I love you." "Then take care of my sheep," Jesus said. A third time he asked him, "Simon son of John, do you love me?" Peter was hurt that Jesus asked the question a third time. He said, "Lord, you know everything. You know that I love you." Jesus said, "Then feed my sheep.*

—John 21:15-17 (NLT)

- *So now I am giving you a new commandment: Love each other. Just as I have loved you, you should love each other. Your love for one another will prove to the world that you are my disciples."*

—John 13:34-35 (NLT)

Follow Through Step:

Spend some time reflecting on what it means for you in your own life that everybody's welcome, nobody's perfect and anything is possible. How do you live out those three signs

by accepting, forgiving and loving the way that Jesus did? Is it possible to do that while also standing up for the truth that the Bible teaches?
