
Good Stuff To Know



Following The Year Of Jesus #26 The Woman At The Well



Jesus had to go through Samaria... Eventually he came to the Samaritan village of Sychar... Jacob's well was there; and Jesus, tired from the long walk, sat wearily beside the well about noontime. Soon a Samaritan woman came to draw water...

—John 4:3-7 (NLT)

Observations On Our Thirst & God's Gift:

1. It's A Surprise.

- *Jesus said to her, "Please give me a drink." ...The woman was surprised.*

—John 4:7 (NLT)

- *Just then his disciples came back. They were shocked to find him talking to a woman.*

—John 4:27 (NLT)

2. Everybody's Thirsty.

- *Everyone who drinks this water will be thirsty again, but whoever drinks the water I give will*

never be thirsty. The water I give will become a spring of water gushing up inside that person, giving eternal life.

—John 4:13-14 (NLT)

4 Things We Blame When We Feel Thirsty:

a. The Things.

- *The Teacher says, “Useless! Useless! Completely useless! Everything is useless.” What do people really gain from all the hard work they do here on earth?*

—Ecclesiastes 1:2-3 (NCV)

b. Myself/Others.

- *As Jesus was walking along, he saw a man who had been blind from birth. “Rabbi,” his disciples asked him, “why was this man born blind? Was it because of his own sins or his parents’ sins?”*

—John 9:1-2 (NLT)

c. God.

- *With a strong hand, God grabs my shirt. He grips me by the collar of my coat. He has thrown me into the mud. I’m nothing more than dust and ashes.*

—Job 30:18-19 (NLT)

d. My Heart.

- *Above everything else guard your heart, because from it flow the springs of life.*

—Proverbs 4:23 (ISV)

3. We Are All Drinking Deeply Somewhere.

- *Soon a Samaritan woman came to draw water, and Jesus said to her, “Please give me a drink.”*

—John 4:7 (NLT)

* *“Please, sir,” the woman said, “give me this*

water! Then I'll never be thirsty again, and I won't have to come here to get water." "Go and get your husband," Jesus told her.

—John 4:15-16 (NLT)

- *The woman said, "I know the Messiah is coming—the one who is called Christ. When he comes, he will explain everything to us." Then Jesus told her, "I am the Messiah!"*

—John 4:25-26 (NLT)

4. Only Jesus Can Quench My Thirst.

- *The woman left her water jar beside the well and ran back to the village, telling everyone, "Come and see a man who told me everything I ever did! Could he possibly be the Messiah?" So the people came streaming from the village to see him.*

—John 4:28-30 (NLT)

- *If you only knew the gift God has for you and who you are speaking to, you would ask me, and I would give you living water.*

—John 4:10 (NLT)

- *Everyone who drinks this water will be thirsty again, but whoever drinks the water I give will never be thirsty. The water I give will become a spring of water gushing up inside that person, giving eternal life.*

—John 4:13-14 (NLT)

Follow Through Step #26:

Reflect on where I am "drinking deeply" trying to satisfy my thirst. Are there things I need to turn over to Jesus?
