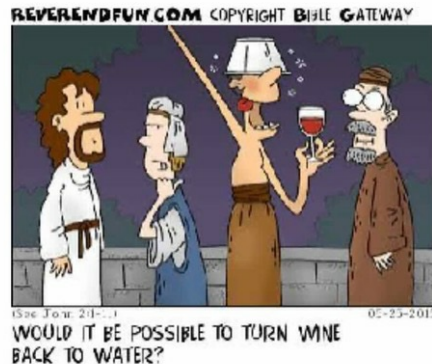


Good Stuff To Know
