Judah, Tamar & The Whole Enchilada

I will bless you and make you famous, and you will be a blessing to others. I will bless those who bless you... All the families on earth will be blessed through you."

Genesis 12:1-3 (NLT)

Matthew 7:12 (NIV)

Observations On The Golden Rule:

1. It's Not A _____.

* Don't misunderstand why I have come. I did not come to abolish the law of Moses or the writings of the prophets. No, I came to accomplish their purpose.

Matthew 5:17 (NLT)

* Our Father in heaven, may your name always be kept holy. May your kingdom come and what you want be done, here on earth as it is in heaven.

Matthew 6:9-10 (NCV)

* Give us the food we need for each day. Forgive us for our sins, just as we have forgiven those who sinned against us.

Matthew 6:11-12 (NCV)

* Then Judah said to Er's brother Onan, "Go and marry Tamar, as our law requires of the brother of a man who has died. You must produce an heir for your brother."

Genesis 38:8 (NLT)

* "Woe to you, teachers of the law and Pharisees, you hypocrites! You give a tenth of your spices--mint, dill and cumin. But you have neglected the more important matters of the law--justice, mercy and faithfulness. You should have practiced the latter, without neglecting the former.

* Then Judah said to Tamar, his daughter-in-law, "Go back to your parents' home and remain a widow until my son Shelah is old enough to marry you." (But Judah didn't really intend to do this because he was afraid Shelah would also die, like his two brothers.) So Tamar went back to live in her father's home.

Genesis 38:11 (NLT)

* But as they were taking her out to kill her, she sent this message to her father-in-law: "The man who owns these things made me pregnant. Look closely. Whose seal and cord and walking stick are these?" Judah recognized them immediately and said, "She is more righteous than I am, because I didn't arrange for her to marry my son Shelah." And Judah never slept with Tamar again.

Genesis 38:25-26 (NLT)

* Then the brothers killed a young goat and dipped Joseph's robe in its blood. They sent the beautiful robe to their father with this message: "Look at what we found. Doesn't this robe belong to your son?"

Genesis 37:31-32 (NLT)

* Although Joseph recognized his brothers, they didn't recognize him.

Genesis 38:8 (NLT)

* So please, my lord, let me stay here as a slave instead of the boy, and let the boy return with his brothers.

Genesis 44:33 (NLT)

* When someone has been given much, much will be required in return; and when someone has been entrusted with much, even more will be required.

Luke 12:48 (NLT)

* Live creatively, friends. If someone falls into sin, forgivingly restore him, saving your critical comments for yourself. You might be needing forgiveness before the day's out. Stoop down and reach out to those who are oppressed. Share their burdens, and so complete Christ's law. If you think you are too good for that, you are badly deceived. Make a careful exploration of who you are and the work you have been given, and then sink yourself into that. Don't be impressed with yourself. Don't compare yourself with others. Each of you must take responsibility for doing the creative best you can with your own life.
