

◆ **WOW! – Adoration**

***“The spirit is willing, but the flesh is weak.” (Matthew 26:41)***

- You know our weaknesses and still call us to follow You.
  - You prepare us for what’s coming before we even see it.
  - You speak truth that protects us, not just informs us.
  - You offer strength beyond our own ability.
  - You don’t leave us alone in the battle; we have Your Spirit.

◆ **THANK YOU! – Gratitude**

***“After I have been raised, I will go ahead of you...” (Mark 14:28)***

- Thank You that You warn us before we fall.
  - Thank You that failure is not the end of our story.
  - Thank You that Your grace meets us even after we mess up.
  - Thank You that You still restore, like You restored Peter.
  - Thank You that Your Spirit gives us power we don’t have on our own.

### ◆ SAVE THEM! – Intercession

***“Watch and pray so that you will not fall into temptation.” (Mark 14:38)***

- Save those who are drifting and not taking Your Word seriously.
  - Rescue those trapped in pride and self-reliance.
  - Awaken those who are spiritually asleep instead of praying.
  - Draw back those who are resisting Your will in their lives.
  - Strengthen those who are facing temptation before they fall.

### ◆ DELIVER ME! – Dependence

  - Help me obey quickly instead of arguing with You.
  - Wake me up to a life of consistent, dependent prayer.
  - Give me the courage to surrender where I’ve been resisting.
  - Strengthen me to rely on Your power, not my own.
