BEAR ONE ANOTHER'S BURDENS

Galatians 6:2 (NIV)

Carry each other's burdens, and in this way you will fulfill the law of Christ.

Be shepherds of God's flock that is under your care, watching over them—not because you must, but because you are willing, as God wants you to be; not pursuing dishonest gain, but eager to serve; not lording it over those entrusted to you, but being examples to the flock. And when the Chief Shepherd appears, you will receive the crown of glory that will never fade away. (1 Peter 5:2-4)

Community: a group of people who matter to you, and to whom you matter.

OroNaz is a community; a group of people united to one another by their union in Christ and their love for one another.

Blueprint for a True Christian Community:

Carry each other's burdens, and in this way you will fulfill the law of Christ.
(Galatians 6:2)

Burdens Come in Various Sizes and Shapes:

- Physical Burdens: Maintenance of homes. Yard. Car repairs. Moving.
- Emotional and Spiritual Burdens: Death of a loved one. Loneliness. Raising small children as a single parent. Health issues. Addiction hang-ups.
- Financial Burdens: Unemployment. Stacks of unpaid bills. Empty pantry. Increased living costs.

Jesus replied: “ ‘Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.’ This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: ‘Love your neighbor as yourself.’ ” (Matthew 22:37-39)

We build community by carrying each other’s burdens, lightening the load for everyone.

In bearing one another’s burdens, we are following the example of Jesus Christ and this pleases God.

Challenge: Think about the burdens you are carrying right now. How many of them are the burdens of others? Ask Jesus to help you be aware, to be looking for opportunities to serve one another, to have your eyes and ears open, sensitive to a need that you can help meet. One of the signs you’ve really encountered Jesus is the willingness to share in the burdens of others.
