(Hebrews 13:8-9) "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, and today, and forever. Do not be carried away by all kinds of strange teachings. It is good to have our hearts strengthened by grace."

JESUS CHRIST NEVER CHANGES, BUT HE CHANGES EVERYTHING (ALL THINGS)

1. A Picture is Worth a Thousand Words
2. Old Story = New Meaning

(Isaiah 43:18-19) "Forget the former things; do not dwell on the past. See, I am doing a new thing. Do you not perceive it? I AM making a way in the desert and streams in the wasteland."

THREE QUESTIONS TO FOCUS ON IN THESE PRESENT TIMES

1. Who Jesus Christ Really Is

(John 1:1-4) "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God and the Word was God. He was with God in the beginning. Through Him all things were made, without Him nothing was made that has been made. In Him was life, and that life was the light of men. The Light shines in the Darkness, but the Darkness has not understood (overcome) it."

(John 1:14) *"The Word became flesh and lived among us. We have seen His glory, the glory of the One and Only, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth."*

2. What He Was Willing To Do and Has Done For Me (and You)

(John 3:16-17) *For God so loved the world that He gave His One and Only Son that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life. For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world but to save the world through Him."*

3. What He Is Doing Today

- He is making new creations: *"Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old is gone. The new has come."*
(2 Corinthians 5:17)
- He is reconciling all things to Himself by making peace through His blood shed on the cross. (Colossians 1:19-20)
