GOING DEEPER

Luke 5:1-11 NIV

One day as Jesus was standing by the Lake of Gennesaret, the people were crowding around him and listening to the word of God.² He saw at the water's edge two boats, left there by the fishermen, who were washing their nets.³ He got into one of the boats, the one belonging to Simon, and asked him to put out a little from shore. Then he sat down and taught the people from the boat.⁴ When he had finished speaking, he said to Simon, "Put out into deep water, and let down the nets for a catch."

⁵ Simon answered, "Master, we've worked hard all night and haven't caught anything. But because you say so, I will let down the nets."⁶ When they had done so, they caught such a large number of fish that their nets began to break.⁷ So they signaled their partners in the other boat to come and help them, and they came and filled both boats so full that they began to sink.

⁸ When Simon Peter saw this, he fell at Jesus' knees and said, "Go away from me, Lord; I am a sinful man!"⁹ For he and all his companions were astonished at the catch of fish they had taken,¹⁰ and so were James and John, the sons of Zebedee, Simon's partners. Then Jesus said to Simon, "Don't be afraid; from now on you will fish for people."¹¹ So they pulled their boats up on shore, left everything and followed him.

F: Foundation

Matthew 7:24-25 (NLT) *Anyone who listens to my teaching and follows it is wise, like a person who builds a house on solid rock.²⁵ Though the rain comes in torrents and the floodwaters rise and the winds beat against that house, it won't collapse because it is built on bedrock.*

O: Obedience

John 15:9-10 (NLT) *I have loved you even as the Father has loved me. Remain in my love.¹⁰ When you obey my commandments, you remain in my love, just as I obey my Father's commandments and remain in his love.*

L: Love

Mark 12:29-31 (NLT) *And you must love the LORD your God with all your heart, all your soul, all your mind, and all your strength.'³¹ The second is equally important: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' No other commandment is greater than these.*

L: Listen

Matthew 17:5-6 (NLT) *But even as he spoke, a bright cloud overshadowed them, and a voice from the cloud said, "This is my dearly loved Son, who brings me great joy. Listen to him."*

O: Offer

Romans 12:1-2 (NIV) *Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship.*

Luke 9:23 (NIV) *Then he said to them all: "Whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross daily and follow me."*

W: Watch & Pray

Mark 14:38 (NIV) *Watch and pray so that you will not fall into temptation. The spirit is willing, but the flesh is weak.*

M: Multiply

Matthew 28:19-20 (NLT) *Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit.²⁰ Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age.*

E: Example

1 Corinthians 11:1 (NIV) *Follow my example, as I follow the example of Christ.*
