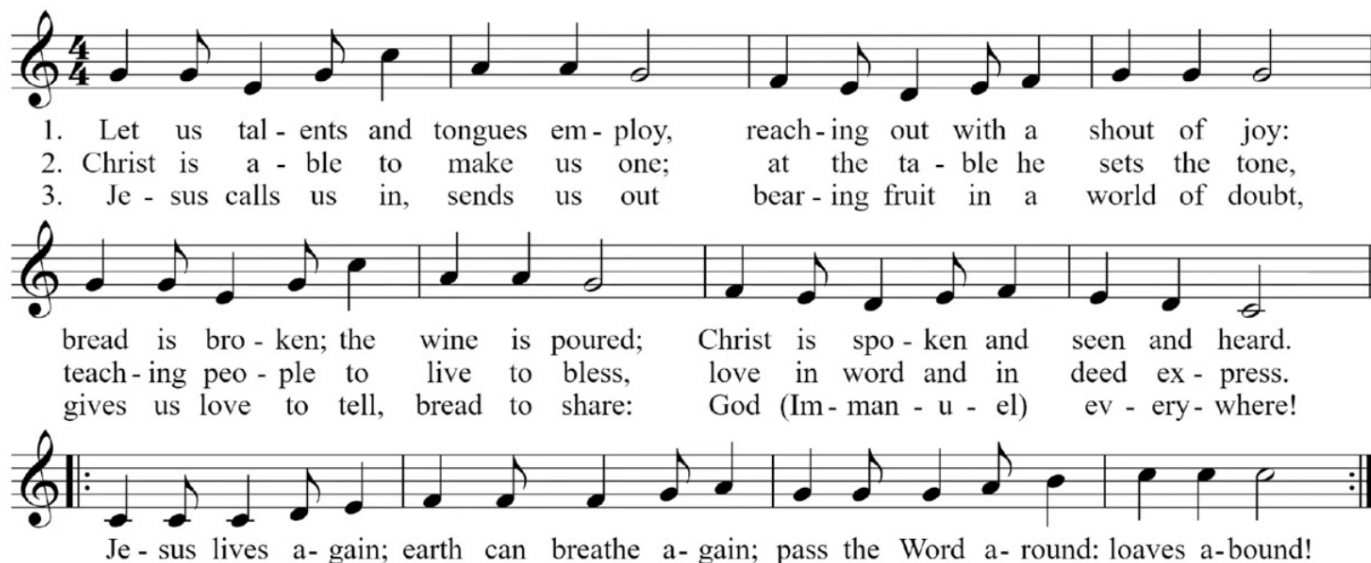
PRAYER OF THANKSGIVING
